






FANTASTIC ROAD AND TRAIN CONNECTIONS TO LONDON

Six miles from the A14 (A1/M1 Link Road), Corby provides easy access to the main north/south roads, the M1/M6 and east coast ports. 'A' roads link the town to Leicester, Northampton, Peterborough and Cambridge. By rail from Corby's new station, London is just over an hour away with services starting early morning through into the evening, with a service directly into St Pancras International.

Priors Hall Park is just over an hour's drive away from three international airports: Birmingham, Nottingham, East Midlands and London Luton. If the bus is your preferred mode of transport then there are plenty of local bus routes connecting you to the towns and villages around Corby and a National Express coach service links the town with Leicester, Nottingham, Leeds and even Glasgow.


