
A GREAT MIX OF HOMES SURROUNDED BY BEAUTIFUL OPEN COUNTRYSIDE


The thriving market town of Market Harborough is just 8 miles to the north and Northampton is just 5 miles to the south, both offering a diverse range of excellent shops, bars and restaurants.

ENJOY LIVING IN THE COUNTRYSIDE

Nestled in the Northamptonshire countryside, Brixworth is surrounded by country parks and reservoirs. Brixworth Country Park lies just opposite Saxon Rise and has stunning views over Pitsford Reservoir, offering great possibilities whether you want to picnic, walk or cycle. Lamport Hall and Gardens is found just beyond Brixworth and opens its doors to the public in the summer – enjoy a picnic or meander around the beautiful gardens.

For the sports enthusiasts, Brixworth offers some fantastic facilities. St David's recreation ground and Central Sports Pavilion provides two football pitches and tennis courts, whilst Haywarns Barns cricket ground is home to the local cricket club. Sailing and fishing can be enjoyed at both Hollowell and Pitsford reservoirs, and there are picturesque golf courses nearby at Church Brampton and Harlestone.



LOCAL AMENITIES


ALL THE ESSENTIALS RIGHT ON YOUR DOORSTEP

Living in Brixworth village, you can enjoy a full range of stores offering all the essential amenities from a local post office, greengrocers and butchers to a Co-operative supermarket, as well as a variety of other independent shops, pubs and restaurants. The village also has its own dental practice and medical surgery.

Recreational facilities in the local area are excellent too. The Centre, Brixworth's community centre, is part of the County Council library building and offers a range of classes from Yoga and Art classes to activities for pre-school children.

There is a wide selection of state and independent schooling in the area. Within the village, there is Brixworth Church of England VC Primary School, with further primary schools found in the surrounding villages. Nearby Spratton Hall School and Pitsford School offer secondary education.





TRANSPORT LINKS

EASY TRAVEL – FANTASTIC ROAD AND TRAIN CONNECTIONS TO LONDON

Saxon Rise has excellent travel links meaning that you can live in a semi-rural location, yet enjoy a quick and easy commute to the nearby larger towns. Located near to the A508, you'll have easy access to the A14 and to the towns of Market Harborough and Northampton. The M1 is also just 10 miles away giving you access to Milton Keynes and beyond.

The village has a daily bus service to Northampton and Leicester. Saxon Rise is also just 6 miles away from Northampton train station, with fast links into London. You'll also have convenient access to Birmingham International, Coventry and East Midlands Airports.

For those who like to cycle to work, why not take the Sustrans cycle route allowing cycleway connection from Brixworth to Northampton.
