**Wildmore's convenient location on the eastern outskirts of Worcester makes this the perfect place for families of all ages to live.**

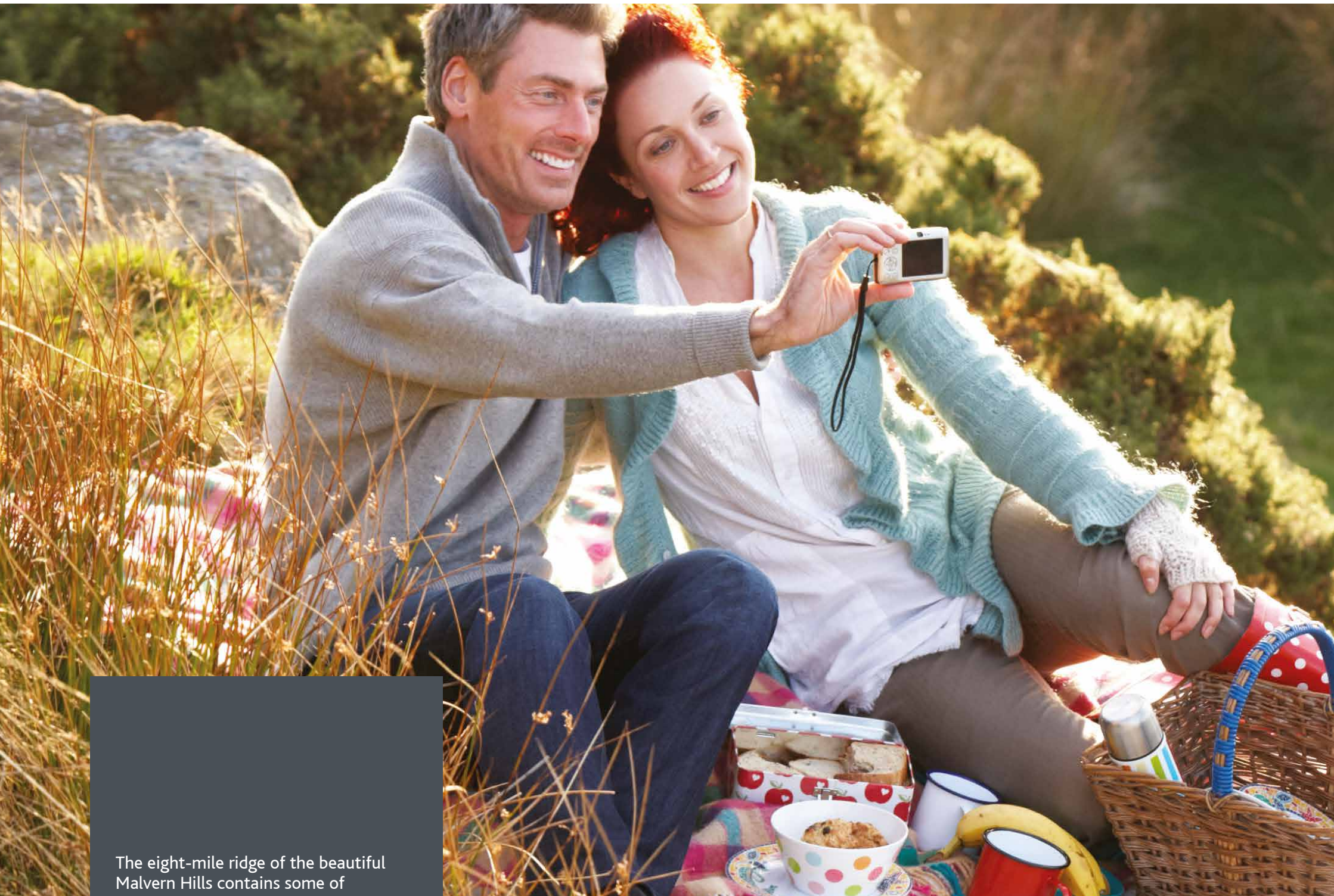
Nunnery Wood Primary and High School, for example, are both a safe and easy 7 minute walk away, whilst Worcester's Sixth Form College is just 4 minutes on foot. Worcester College of Technology can also be reached in around 10 minutes by bike.

The highly regarded University of Worcester, one of the fastest growing Universities in Britain, is also just a 15 minute drive away.

Those considering private education are also spoilt for choice. Originally founded in around 685, The Royal Grammar School is the sixth oldest school in the world and, lying in the shadows of the cathedral, there is Kings Worcester, founded in 1541 by Henry VIII.

There are countless other options in the independent sector with highly regarded schools and colleges available in nearby Malvern and Cheltenham.





The eight-mile ridge of the beautiful Malvern Hills contains some of the oldest rocks in Britain and a walk here was considered so challenging by famous explorer George Mallory, that he walked here in preparation for his ascent of Everest.

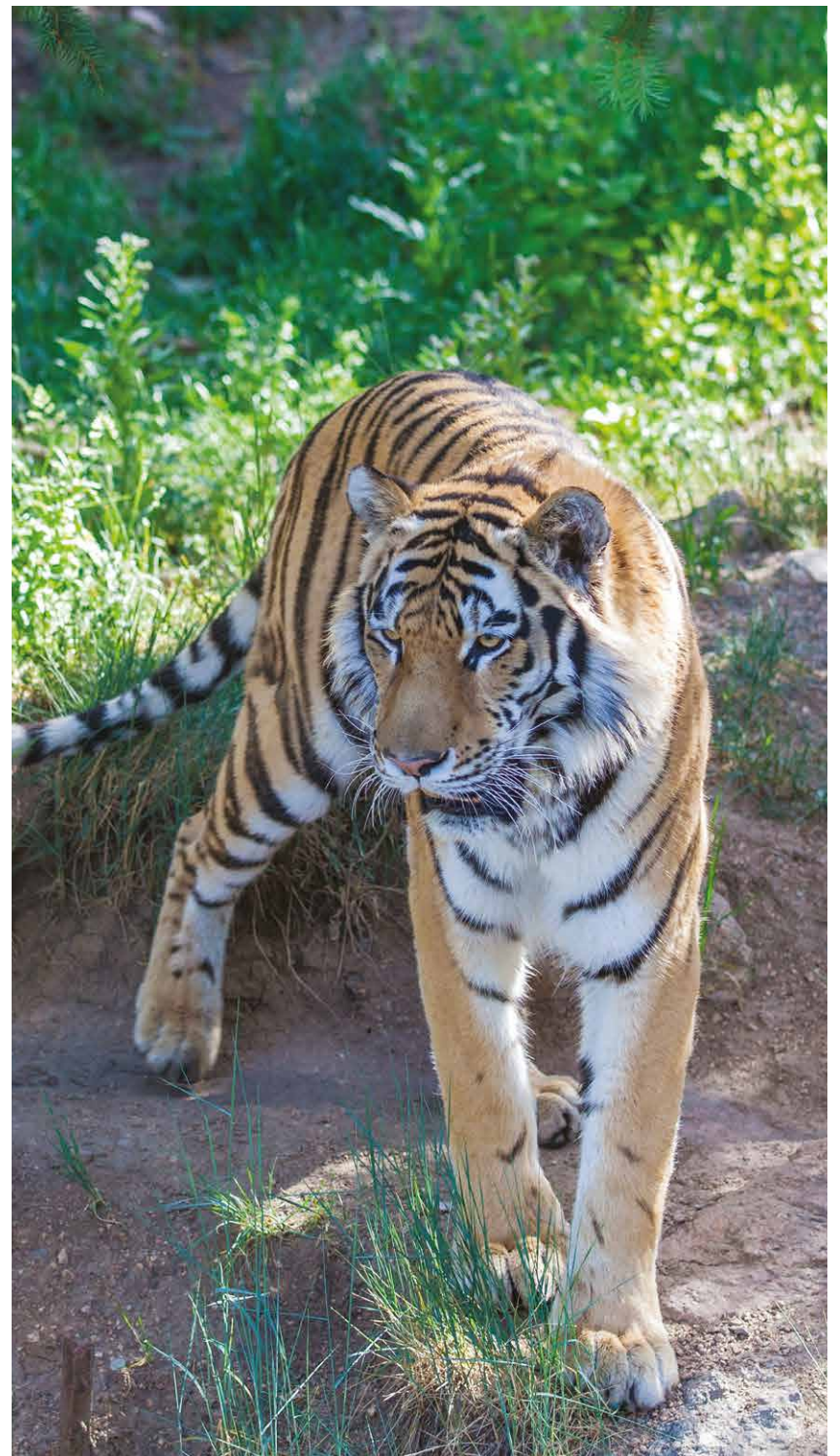

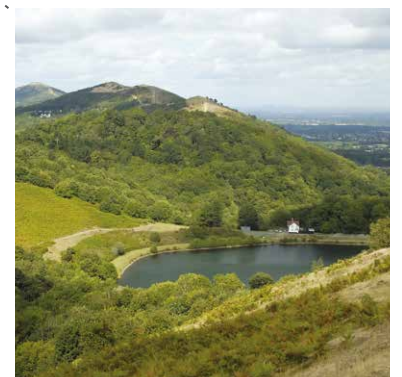
