Another way to spend the day is exploring the surrounding countryside. Why not don your walking boots and follow the Medway Valley Walk along the banks of the River Medway? Brambledown enjoys excellent connections in terms of both rail and road. East Farleigh Station is 2.4 miles from the homes and offers trains to London in just over an hour, while Staplehurst and Maidstone East and West Stations are also close by making for excellent rail opportunities. For road networks, the A229 is at the end of Cripple Street and leads into the M20 and therefore the M26 and M25.

Maidstone West Station - 14 min drive / 2 miles >
Trains to London St Pancras in 1 hour 3 minutes

East Farleigh Station - 8 min drive / 2.4 miles >
Trains to London St Pancras in 1 hour 9 minutes

Maidstone East Station - 16 min drive / 2.6 miles >
Trains to London Victoria in 57 minutes

Staplehurst Station - 15 min drive / 7.2 miles >
Trains to London Charing Cross in 1 hour 2 minutes
