The area also boasts several well-regarded secondary schools, including Chertsey's Salesian School, also rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted.

There are several international schools nearby too including the International School of London, Surrey, the American Community School (with campuses in Cobham and Egham), and The American School in England in nearby Thorpe.*

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A direct train from the village's dedicated Longcross station transports you directly to London Waterloo in under 50 minutes*, and plans are underway to increase the frequency of the service offered by South West Trains. Direct links are also available to Reading, Ascot and Richmond, among other destinations.
