

Summary

A recently updated former farmhouse that has been thoughtfully extended and renovated over the years to now provide generous family accommodation. The property is set in beautiful mature gardens with ample parking and a number of outbuildings set within a total plot of 1/2 an acre.







About the area

Burtle is a small hamlet on the edge of the village of Westhay, a village and civil parish 3 miles north-west of Glastonbury which has been a settled site for even longer than Glastonbury. Burtle has a vibrant community, Gastro local pub vibrant village hall and societies and clubs. Nearby are the nature reserves of Westhay Moor and Westhay Heath, which have both been designated as sites of special scientific interest. There is easy access to the other towns of the area including Wells, Glastonbury, Street and Wedmore whilst Bristol and Yeovil are well within commuting distance. Description

Entered via a reception hall with with doors off to the principle rooms. A beautiful latch and brace door opens to the large farmhouse style kitchen / breakfast room that comprises mixture of wall and base units, wooden worktops over, rayburn cooker, flagstone floors and stripped beams. The kitchen / breakfast room leads through to a well proportioned snug with beautiful inglenook fire, inset woodburning stove and stripped beams. Adjacent to the snug is a large utility room with access to the courtyard. To the other side of the property is a well proportioned sitting room with inglenook and inset multi fuelstove, stripped beams and window with window seat that overlooks the attractive front garden. Beyond this there is a downstairs bedroom with large dressing area that has french doors to the garden. The spacious downstairs bathroom has an attractive antique victorian bath with separate shower. Upstairs there are a further four large bedrooms and a cloakroom. The master bedroom has a beautiful balcony ideal for sunbathing in the summer and sitting out in the evening.









Outside


Approached via double gates that lead to a large parking area with parking for a number of vehicles. The sucluded rear garden and courtyard leads to several outbuildings. The front garden is mainly laid to lawn with a verity of specimen trees and herbaceous borders. The approach to the house is very attractive with a beautiful wisteria that is currently in bloom. To the side of the property is a two storey stone building that could be utilised as further accommodation (subject to necessary consents being obtained, the current owners have attained planning permission in the past and plans are available to see). A pathway further leads to an expanse of grass where beautiful views can be had over the levels. A further outbuilding comprises an attractive orangery, workshop and store rooms. Total plot 1/2 an acre.

Directions

Proceed from our estate agent in Wedmore in the direction of Mark, passing the White Horse Pub on your right take the next left into Yarrow road turn right into Southwich Road. Turn left signposted to Burtle after 1.9 miles turn right into Robins Lane. Continue for a short distance where the property will be found on the right hand side.






