10-11 Lancaster Gate were built as part of larger development of Victorian luxurious terraced houses which consisted of twenty one residences. They were originally built as Victorian first class town mansions by builder and developer John Kelk in 1862. No 10-11 Lancaster Gate were built for residential purposes, comprise seven storeys including basement and attic in classical Victorian style and have an abundance of internal and external features of the era.
