Long Meadow Walk, Lagan Homes' selection of 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 bedroom homes, is located within the new community emerging at Little Stanion, beside the A43 to the south east of Corby.

From the Domesday Book until the mid 20th Century nearby Corby was just a village itself, but in the 1910 iron production came to the area to take advantage of vast of deposits of ironstone, and the population multiplied as workers came from as far a field as Scotland. However by the 1973 the steel works closed and the area faced decline. Corby was designated an Enterprise Zone in 1990 and new industries were attracted to the town and today it is once again vibrant.

Modern day Corby boasts a shopping centre, a sports centre, an Olympic-sized swimming pool and the new Civic Hub due for completion this year as well as a wide range of pubs and restaurants. Nearby attractions include Kirby Hall, Rockingham Castle, Rockingham Motor Speedway and Priors Hall Golf Course. There area is also surrounded by attractive wooded countryside and country parks for outdoor pursuits.

A sign of this new confidence in the area is the return of the railway to Corby in the Spring of 2009, after a forty year absence, with an award-winning new station (Britain's newest). There is an hourly East Midlands Train service to London St Pancras (85 mins).

Road travel links in all directions are excellent. To the south near Kettering is the A14 linking to the M1/M6 in the west and A1(M)/M11 in the east.

The village benefits from its neighbouring historic market towns and all the amenities they have to offer, making Little Stanion a truly traditional village for a modern age.





