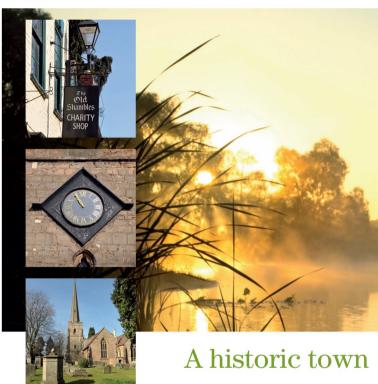


Welcome to a fantastic collection of 2, 3 and 4 bedroom homes in the historic market town of Newent, created by Linden Homes.

Some of the timber-framed buildings were built over 500 years ago, while newer homes have been built or refurbished to perfectly complement the distinct style of the town.

the streets, while cosy tearooms greet you at every turn.

For that essential weekly food shop, supermarkets such as Tesco and Sainsbury's lie within 10 miles of the development, while local pubs The George, The Red Lion Inn and The Black Dog are less than a mile away.¹

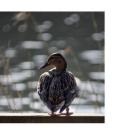
For those with children, there are a number of schools within a few miles of the development. Primary schools include Picklenash Junior School and Pountley Church of England Primary School, while for older children, secondary schools include Newent Community School and Dene Magna School. In terms of further education, Cloucester University and the Royal Forest of Dean College are just two of many nearby options.

Commuting to work is convenient too. Gloucester (9 miles) and Cheltenham (17 miles) are a short drive via the B4215 and A40. Further affeld, Bristol (44 miles) and Birmingham (60 miles) are reached via the M5 motonvay. The nearest station is at Gloucester, with trains to Bath, Bristol and connections to the National Rail Network. Bristol International Airport is just 40 miles away.

Whether you enjoy shopping, history or sport and leisure pursuits, there is plenty on offer to keep you occupied in and around Newent. To learn more about the history of the area, The Market House and Heritage Museum tells the fascinating story of the town from prehistoric and Roman eras. Beautiful surroundings make for great walking or picnic areas; Newent Lake is set in the grounds of the former Newent Court, and is created from the fish ponds of the monks who arrived with William the Conqueror. To enjoy the beauty of Newent's famous wild daffodils, which are abundant in spring, walkers can follow several different routes.

For fresh, local produce, Nevent markets are held weekly on Thursdays. If it's high-street shops you're after, Cloucester, Cheltenham, Ross-on-Wye and Hereford are all within easy reach. As well as big-name brands, they also have a wider range of restaurants, bars and entertainment facilities to keep the whole family happy.

For sports enthusiasts, Newent Leisure Centre and Golf Club are both local to the development.

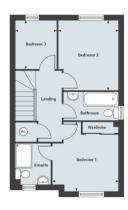

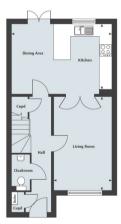

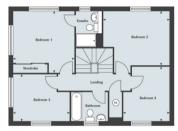

From M50 take Junction 3 toward B4221 to Newent. Turn right on the B4216 then left onto Church Street and right onto Gloucester Road. Take the second right onto Onslow Road and the first left onto Meek Road. Meadow Grove is at the end of Meek Road.
