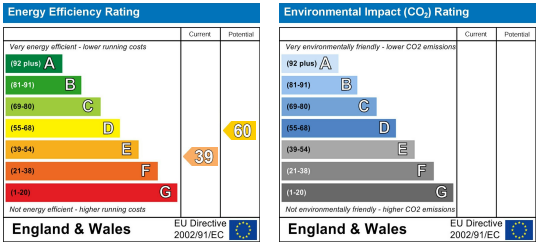
Area Map
