

Mount Edgcumbe Terrace Guide Price £280,000

Situated in a traffic-free terrace of lovely period houses, overlooking Falmouth town centre, is this cosy two bedroom property with an enclosed garden to the rear.

Mount Edgcumbe Terrace is a most charming terrace of period properties, accessed via a pedestrian pathway from Webber Hill, with pretty front gardens enjoying elevated views over The Moor and just a few minutes' walk down into the centre of Falmouth town.

On the ground floor an entrance hall opens into the openplan lounge and dining room with large sash windows at either end, high ceilings and a feature fireplace. To the rear a doorway leads through to the kitchen with access to a rear courtyard and garden.







Stairs lead from the entrance hall to the first floor and there is a sash window which floods the stairwell with natural light. From the landing there are two double bedrooms, the principle bedroom having a feature fireplace and far reaching views.

There is also a large airing cupboard which houses the hot water immersion heater and a bathroom with shower over bath.

Externally, there is a small front garden area accessed across the pathway and to the rear there is a courtyard with an external utility. A couple of steps lead up to an enclosed lawned garden with some steep terracing beyond leading to a currently unused rear pedestrian access from Quarry Hill.

Electric heating provided by storage heaters and economical panel ceiling heaters on the ground floor. Electric Immersion Heater for Hot Water. Enclosed rear garden.


