A terraced period property with 3 bedrooms, 2 reception rooms, 2 separate cloakrooms and a rear garden with access from a well maintained pathway. This home is chain free and could be a great starter home or investment property.

Three bedroom terraced property

This chain free property has two reception rooms and a bright kitchen with a low maintenance rear garden. This well presented home is a great opportunity as a starter home, investment property or to downsize.

Interior

Decorated in neutral tones throughout, this period terraced cottage is light and bright.

The kitchen has a Bosche oven and four ring gas hob with space and plumbing for the Bosche washing machine, all set within the green wooden base and wall units. A bathroom with basin is separate from a WC at the rear of the property.

Under the stairs is a useful storage space that could be purposed as a utility area.

There are two reception rooms with one having a bay window and a recessed area within the chimney breast and tiled hearth.

Upstairs there is a convenient cloakroom and three bedrooms. Two are doubles with feature fireplaces and a single bedroom, or office, overlooks the garden.

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Exterior

At the front of the property is a small easily maintained garden to the right of the short flight of steps leading to the entrance door.

The low maintenance rear garden is mainly paved with some mature shrubs and a flower bed, a short path leads to a low picket gate that gives useful rear access to the property.

This mainly westerly facing garden is great for the afternoon and early evening sun.

Cowes

Cowes is rich in nautical heritage and an international mecca for sailing, culminating in Cowes Week held in August each year. It has quick access to Southampton via the more modern Red Jet as well as many marinas and sailing clubs dotted along the waterfront. Within the High Street there are two supermarkets, many boutique shops, pubs and eateries. Historical Northwood House & Park hosts weddings, fairs, concerts and conferences with outside space to enjoy walks. The chain ferry, known locally as 'The Floaty', links Cowes to East Cowes where the Red Funnel car and passenger ferry to the mainland is situated.
