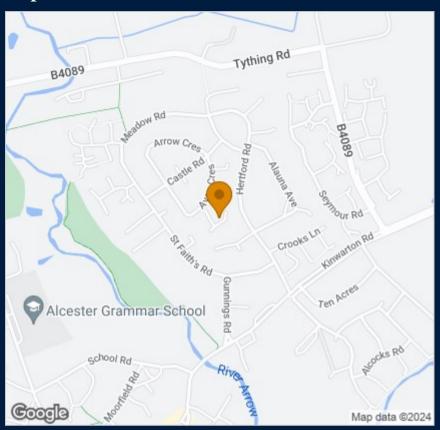

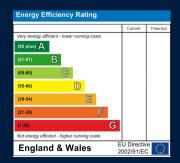
### Floor Plan
