Built 7 years ago by Redrow Homes, the property has 3 years remaining of its 10-year NHBC warranty.

Internally the property has been very wellmaintained and offers comfortable accommodation to include; Reception hall with access to the Downstairs Cloakroom, Living room with picture window to front, open-plan, contemporary Dining/Kitchen with granite work-surfaces, integrated appliances (including a Quooker tap), Antico flooring and french doors to the garden.

Upstairs, the landing provides access to a modern Family Bathroom with porcelenosa fitments and antico floor. There are THREE good size Bedrooms, two of which have fitted wardrobes and an Ensuite in the main bedroom.

Outside; To the front the property has a small frontage filled with attractive shrubs and a path to the front door. To the side there is a paved drive with parking for two vehicles and access into the DETACHED GARAGE.

The Rear Garden IS SOUTH-FACING and has been smartly landscaped and includes an attractive paved patio across the rear and up one side which encloses two circular lawns. Shrub borders to side edge the lawns and rear fencing. A door provides pedestrian access into the Garage which forms part of the garden perimeter with further area at rear with a timber shed.

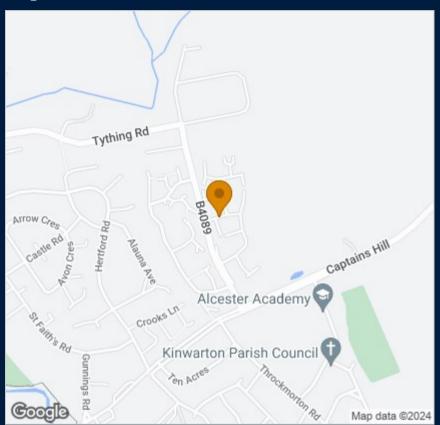

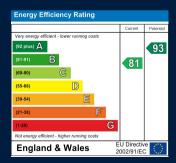
Floor Plan
