'Walnut Tree Cottage' is a stunning detached Grade II listed family home, situated in the idyllic and picturesque village of Abbots Morton. breaming with character features including exposed wall and ceiling timbers, and set in large gardens to rear and side, with driveway parking for numerous vehicles and an attached double garage.

The property, although habitable is in need of Updating and Modernisation and would make an ideal on-going project. Currently, the accommodation includes; an impressive reception hall, downstairs WC, large living room with inglenook fireplace and windows to two aspects, a snug or formal dining room with feature fireplace, good size farmhouse-style breakfast kitchen with an Everhot oil-fired cooker, utility room and pantry and access to the integral double garage/workshop.

Upstairs, the landing gives access to Three large double bedrooms, one of which with ensuite bathroom, and a further family bathroom. Outside the rear garden is mainly laid to lawn interspersed with several mature fruit trees, and enclosed to all sides with further lawned garden to one side. To the other side a gated driveway leads to the rear with further gates opening to rear parking and the garage, The property has an one attached and one detached outhouse as well as a timber shed and summerhouse. The frontage is laid to lawn with iron fencing and gate to small pedestrian path leading to the front door.



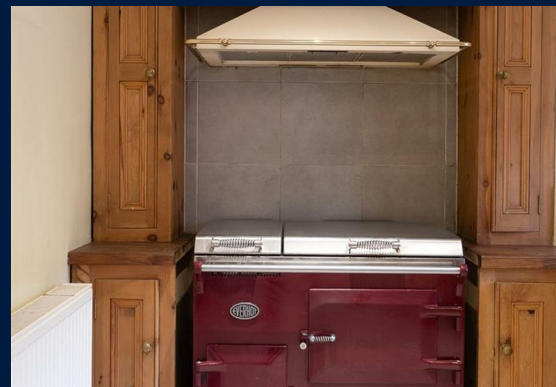

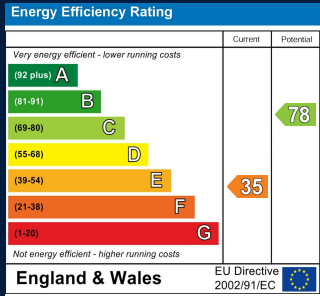
Floor Plan
