A beautifully presented, modern Mid-Terrace property set in charming surroundings with open park views to the front and a delightful well-tended communal courtyard at the rear. The property has its own small Courtyard-style Garden backing onto the courtyard and allocated parking for one vehicle on the development.

'Chestnut Court' was built approx. 26 years ago and is situated literally 3 minutes walk from the High Street making it extremely convenient for access to the many excellent amenities that the town has to offer.

The accommodation is approached from Chestnut Court through a pedestrian gate into the courtyard garden leading to the front door. Enter into the Reception Hall with staircase to the first floor and doors opening to the Living room and the Kitchen. The Living is a large bright room with window and french doors which overlook and open to the views over Centenary Park. The fully fitted Kitchen has a window to rear over the garden and has space (and plumbing) for all appliances.

Upstairs, the Landing leads to TWO DOUBLE BEDROOMS and a modern fitted Shower room. Both bedrooms have attractive views, Bed 1 to Centenary Park at the front and Bed 2 to the well-tended communal courtyard of Chestnut Court.


Floor Plan
