Hallway

L-shaped hallway leading to all accommodation. Easily accessible loft hatch with a pull-down ladder.

Lounge/Diner

Flooded with natural light that streams in through the large UPVC double-glazed window, with views over the front of the property. Spacious living room, with ample room for both dining furniture and a sofa suite.

Kitchen

A brand-new fitted kitchen with newly installed integrated hob, oven and extractor fan, and newly installed integrated dishwasher. Unit space for an upright fridge/freezer. Two windows make the room bright and airy, with external access through a side door.

With the luxury of both a fitted bathtub and a corner, mains-fed shower unit, this modern tiled bathroom is designed to suit everyone's needs. Completed with a low-level flush WC, pedestal basin and a chrome heated towel rail.

Outside

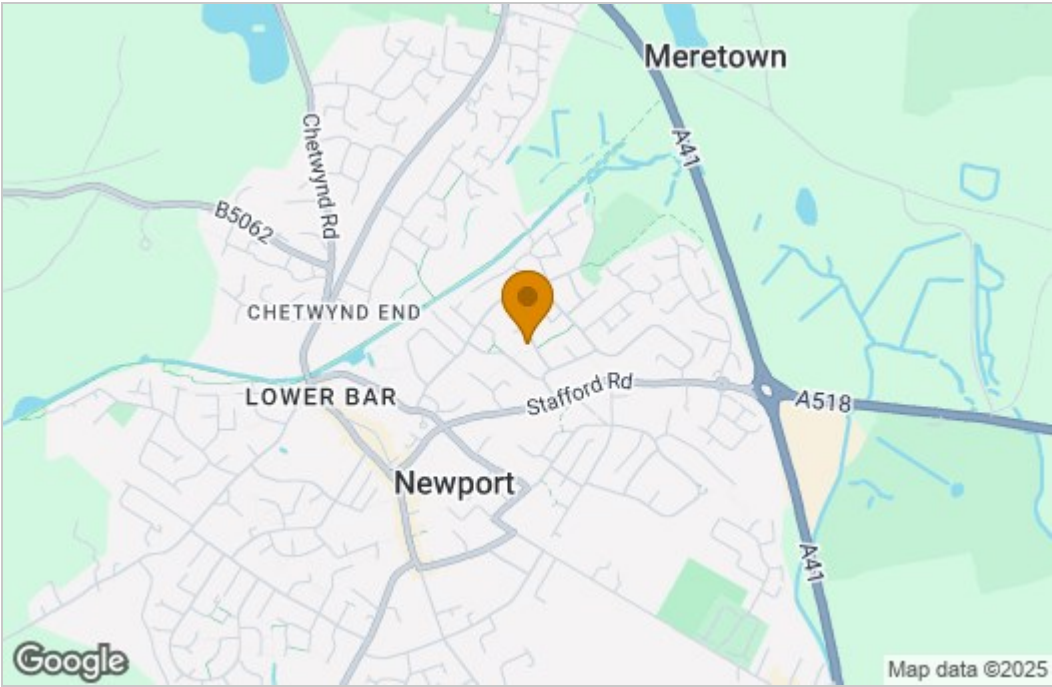

Floor Plan

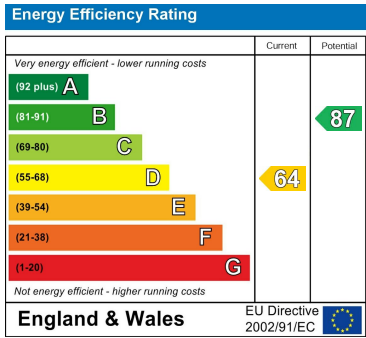
