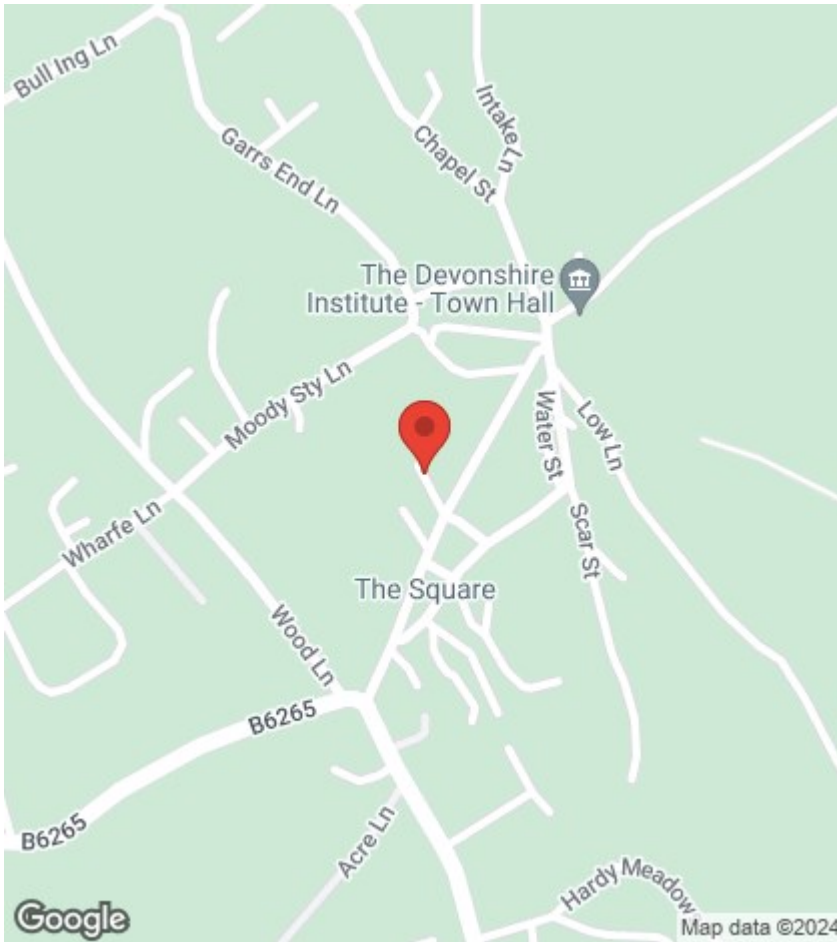
PROPERTY DETAILS
