### Prestigious location

As you travel along exclusive Beech Hill, you'll pass a discrete turning into a private road with a gated entrance. Welcome to Whitestone Close. At the end of the softly lit, landscaped driveway you'll arrive at number 1, an impressive white detached home.

Built in 2012, this is a luxurious and spacious home, designed comfortable living. And as there are only two properties in Whitestone Close, you can be sure that you will have a very high level of privacy. Let us give you the guided tour:

### A Warm Welcome

As the electronic gates open and you pass down the landscaped driveway, you can feel the warm lights of 'Belle Vue' welcoming you home.

At the end, there is space for several cars and a detached double garage shrouded in sweet smelling wisteria.

### Friends and Family

Step onto the marble doorstep, push open the dark wood double doors and enter into the expansive hallway, where an impressive chandelier twinkles overhead. Take a seat while you remove your coat and shoes, and experience the oak flooring underfoot. Store your items away in the floor to ceiling wardrobes that are off to the left, next to the

first guest cloakroom.

Returning to the hallway, look straight ahead and you'll see the gleaming white floor and walls of the family room contrasting against the green of the back garden.

This vast room really is the heart of the home. It is the room the current owners will miss most as it's where their family spend all their time when they are together. With three distinct areas for cooking, dining and reclining, there is enough space for everyone to do their own thing and yet still be together.

The designer kitchen at the far end has composite granite surfaces which stand out against the white background. The central island is a wonderful informal setting for chatting over a cup of tea or a quick bite to eat. Off to the side of the kitchen area is the utility room which has white units, appliances for washing and drying clothes, a sink and a semi-glazed door to a hidden outside area (ideal for drying clothes alfresco but keeping them out of sight!).

In the centre of the family room is the dining area which fills the recessed bay and so is surrounded by windows and doors to the garden. This is a wonderful space for a sunny lunch with friends or a romantic evening meal for two.

Back at the entrance of the family room is the lounge area, a comfortable and relaxed zone for the family to chill out at the end of the day or for everyone to gather round and watch TV or play video games on a plus-size, wall-mounted screen.





### Formal Sophistication

As you re-enter the hallway, turn to the left and you'll find the formal lounge. A striking limestone fireplace makes a bold statement and is complemented beautifully by floor to ceiling mirrors in the alcoves. Glazed doors provide another means of accessing the garden and allow natural light to flood into the room and to reflect off the mirrors, making this a bright and vibrant space throughout the day. At the other end of the lounge, wooden double doors open into the grand dining room where a stunningly elegant chandelier immediately grabs your attention. In the evening, if you look past the chandelier and through the windows, the view along the driveway is equally inspiring.

A second door takes you back to the hallway where, diagonally opposite, there is an additional reception room which would be ideal as a snug or TV room, or perhaps a dedicated office space. Back across the hallway a grand wooden staircase with plush cream carpet takes you upstairs.

### Retire to Complete Luxury

Once again, the impressive modern chandelier makes a beautiful focal point, and a large window gives an alternative view of the driveway. Six doors lead from the landing, two provide some welcome storage space, the remaining four each lead to a stunning bedroom suite with Villeroy and Boch en suite bathrooms.

The principal suite is an exquisitely cool and tranquil sanctuary. In this bedroom large mirrors reflect light from equally large windows, giving an impression of more space and additional rooms. The walk-through



dressing area allows for clothes and accessories to be stored and displayed so you can select the perfect outfit before entering the bathroom. The bath has a solid surround which is ideal for a few candles or a glass of wine while you bathe. A separate shower cubicle is just the thing for busy mornings, and a large double sink with his 'n' hers taps adds to the feeling of personal space.

The three remaining bedrooms on this floor are also quite luxurious. Very generous sizes, all with tall windows allowing in lots of natural light, and all with en suite bathrooms. Two of these suites also have dressing areas while the third has stylish built-in wardrobes that fill the width of the bedroom.

Returning to the landing, a second set of stairs leads upwards to the next equally spacious landing with an arched feature window and view over the driveway.

#### Flexibility and Independence

On this floor there is a fifth bedroom suite. The sloping of the eaves around the bed gives this room a very cosy feel, while the Velux window directly above makes this the perfect room for dreamers to gaze at the stars before falling asleep. In the morning, wake to the sunlight overhead and walk through the dressing area to the light and bright en suite bathroom.

As you leave the bedroom suite there are three further rooms to explore on this level. The first is the second guest cloakroom, opposite this is a reception room which would be ideal as a cinema room or possibly a gym. The third room is a studio room with a large open space and a kitchenette in the recessed area. This top floor would provide excellent private
