5 Upper Meadow

An impressive and individually designed detached residence, set within a secluded and highly desirable location in the charming village of Walsham-le-Willows. Offering over 2,500 square feet of thoughtfully arranged living space, this substantial home is positioned on a generous quarter-acre plot. The property also features a detached double garage with an upper-level studio, ideal for a home office or creative space, along with a separate workshop, providing excellent versatility and functionality.











Step Inside

The property is entered via a welcoming entrance hall, which includes useful storage and a cloakroom, and flows seamlessly into the heart of the home—a striking open-plan L-shaped living room. This expansive, light-filled space is beautifully enhanced by large windows, glazed patio doors, and skylights, creating a bright and inviting atmosphere throughout. A characterful inglenook-style fireplace, complete with an oak bressummer and a log-burning stove, provides a warm and cosy focal point.

The adjoining farmhouse-style kitchen is well-appointed with an extensive range of hardwood cabinetry and integrated appliances, including an electric hob, oven, fridge/freezer, and dishwasher. A separate utility room offers additional storage and dedicated space for laundry facilities. The principal bedroom suite is conveniently located on the ground floor and enjoys a tranquil outlook over the front garden. It features built-in wardrobes and a generous en suite bathroom fitted with a bath, separate shower, WC, and wash basin. On the first floor, two further spacious bedroom suites each benefit from their own en suite shower rooms. Additionally, a versatile dressing room offers excellent flexibility offering an abundance of storage space.













Step Outside

The property is approached via a concrete driveway, offering generous off-road parking and access to a detached double garage with twin upand-over doors. Inside, a staircase leads to a spacious first-floor studio or office space.

The mature rear garden provides a high degree of privacy and is predominantly laid to lawn, framed by well-established shrub borders. A charming patio area, complete with a pergola and accessible from both the reception room and kitchen, offers an inviting setting for alfresco dining, relaxing, and entertaining.





Location

The sought after village of Walsham-le-Willows is home to the popular bar and restaurant, The Blue Boar. There is a strong sense of community in the village with many events and clubs organised through the village hall and other amenities with multiple shops and businesses, a gym, primary school and excellent connections to the historic market town of Bury St Edmunds.

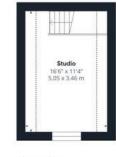
