West Lavant is an unspoilt gem of a location, being "off the beaten track", yet within a relatively short drive of Chichester itself. Boasting numerous places of interest nearby, including an equestrian centre, the world famous Goodwood racecourse and the motor racing circuit.

The entrance hall opens onto the double aspect sitting room with feature fireplace and log burner. The kitchen/breakfast room, which is deceptively spacious is fitted with a good range of units with solid wood work surfaces and space for appliances. There is ample room for table and chairs. A downstairs cloakroom completes the ground floor accommodation.

To the first floor there are 2 double bedrooms and shower room. A further steep staircase leads to a useful attic room with generous eaves storage.

The delightful wraparound gardens are mainly to lawn with trees, plants and shrubs and hedging offering privacy. There is a seating area to the front, which is southerly in aspect, providing a perfect secluded sun trap. The rear garden affords stunning views across the South Downs.

The property is approached via a shared driveway, which in turn leads to 3 garages, one of which belongs to the property. The garage has been sub-divided to create a small studio/hobbies room.


