found at rear with carpets, papered walls and textured ceilings which are coved with central light fittings, patio doors to conservatory, radiator.

a victorian style conservatory with tiled flooring, dwarf walls and glazed sides and French doors to rear, correx roofing.

6'4" x 5'7" (1.93m x 1.70m)

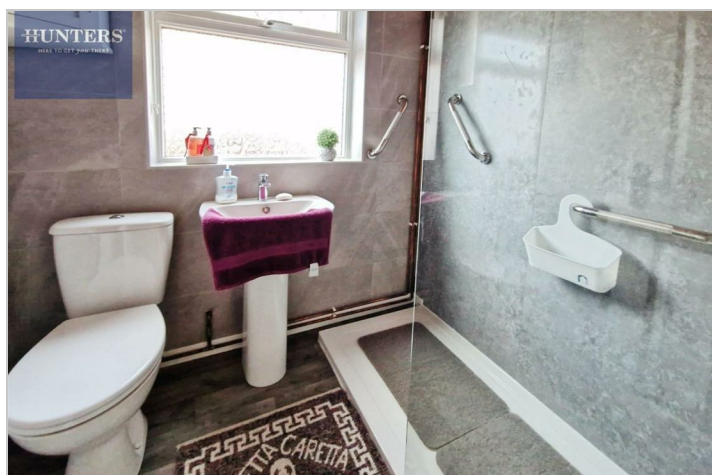

Gardens

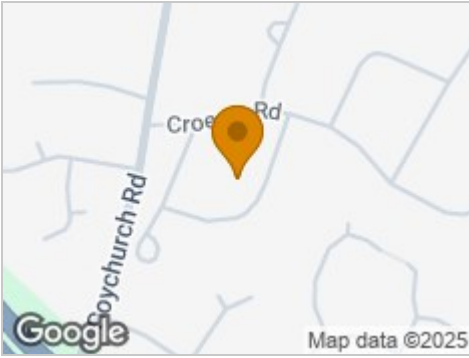
Enclosed rear garden, patio area off the back of the house, middle chipped area with path to side, mature borders with some bushes and plants, rear, side gated access to front.

There is a garage with power and lighting, up and over front door.

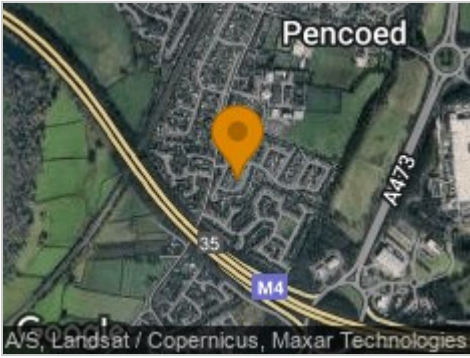
The front of the house enclosed with block paved drive extending to side for 2 vehicles, front garden is patio with some mature borders.

Terrain Map



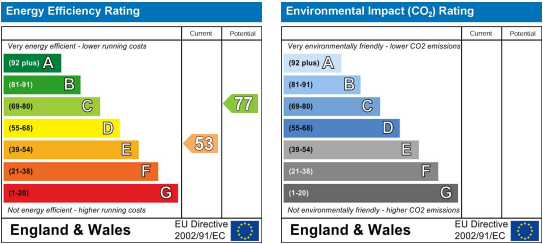
Floor Plan
