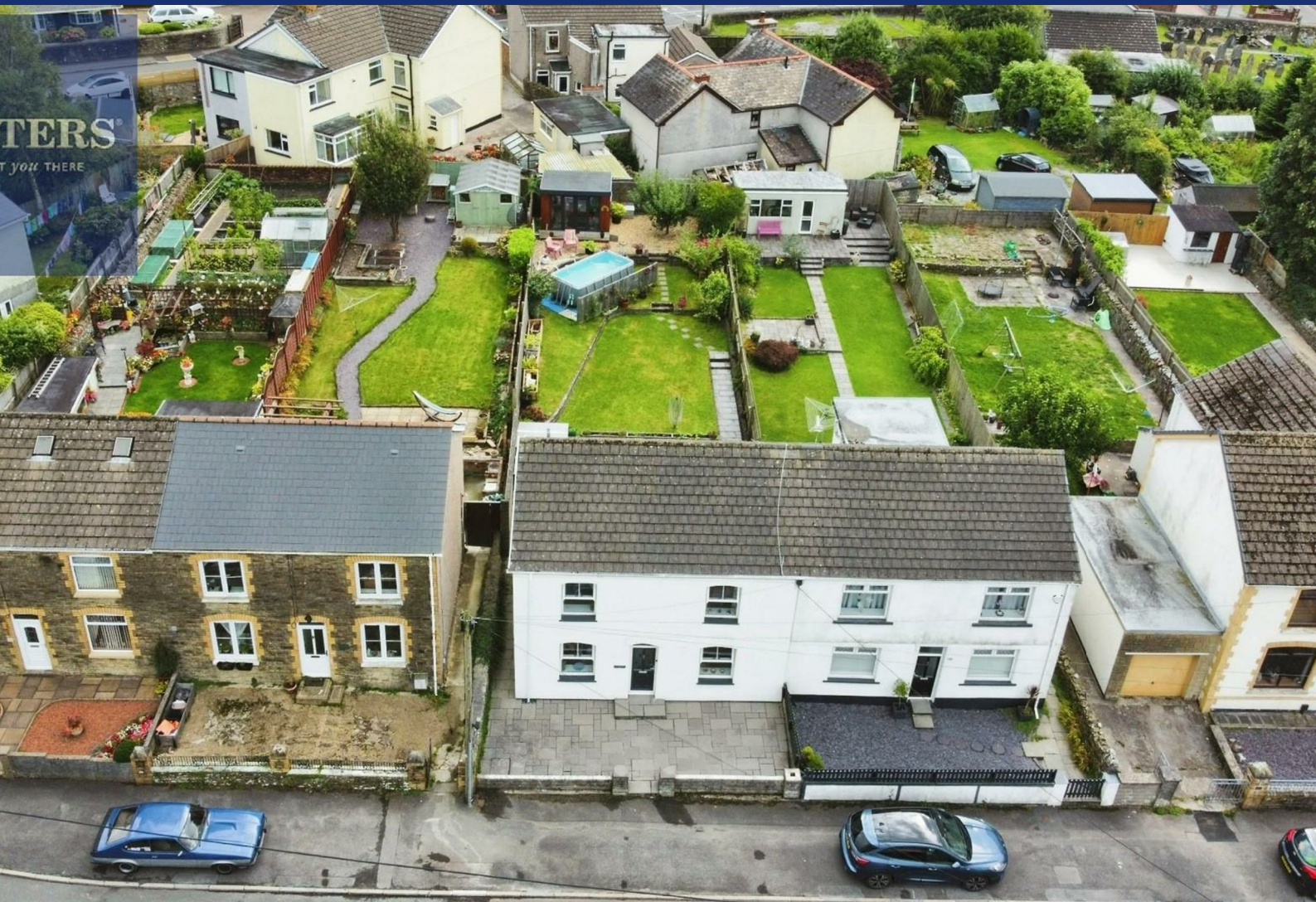

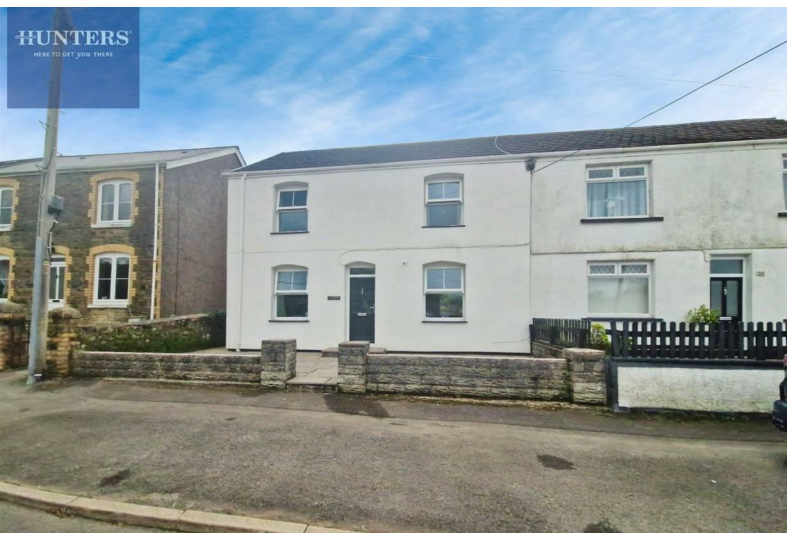

With tile effect flooring, skimmed walls and ceiling which is coved with central and spot lighting, upright radiator. Fitted kitchen with a selection of base and wall units in blue shaker style with compressed quartz worktops, integral sink & drainer, electric oven, 5 burner induction hob and hood, window to front and rear, door to rear utility.

Utility

10'1" x 9'10" (3.07m x 3.00m)

with tile effect flooring, skimmed walls and ceiling which are coved with central lighting, wall unit in grey with granite effect worktops, plumbing for washing machine & dishwasher, wall mounted boiler 18 months old.

Cloakroom

with tile effect flooring, skimmed walls and ceiling which are covered with central lighting, wc wand wash basin, window to rear.

Landing

with carpets, skimmed walls and ceilings which are covered with central lighting, wood banister with spindles, window to rear, doors to:

with carpets, skimmed walls and ceiling which is covered with central lighting, radiator, window to front, built in wardrobes along one wall.

Bedroom 2

12'1" x 10'2" (3.68m x 3.10m)

with carpets, skimmed walls and ceiling with central lighting, radiator, window to front.

Bedroom 3

9'1" x 8'10" (2.77m x 2.69m)

with carpets, skimmed walls and ceiling with central lighting, radiator, window to rear.

Bathroom

9'10" x 8'10" (3.00m x 2.69m)

With tile effect flooring, skimmed walls and ceiling with spot lighting, 3-piece suite comprising bath, hand basin and WC, separate double shower cubicle with thermostatic waterfall shower and glass screen, window to rear, radiator.

Garden

Front enclosed garden which is block paved.

Enclosed rear garden which is 90ft in length, patio area against the rear of the property with side access, steps up to the a central lawn area, rear chipped area. Selection of mature beds and trees around the garden.

purpose built cedar clad insulated home office/cinema room with power, lighting & heating, French doors with side panels to front.

Terrain Map



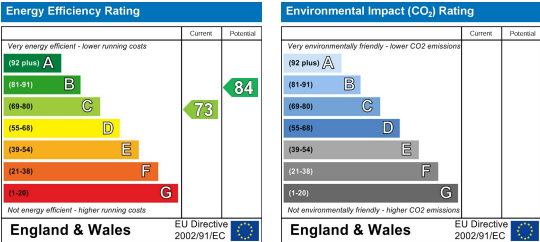
Floor Plan
