The Cathedral town of Bury St Edmunds lies in West Suffolk at the heart of East Anglia famous for its Benedictine Abbey. The town has extensive facilities and amenities to cater for all walks of life and has exceptional transport links. The A14 bypasses the town and links the Midlands with the East coast. London via the M11 is 60 miles. The railway station offers services to Cambridge, Norwich and Ipswich with connections for London. A commuter rail link is available at Stowmarket.

A spacious town house on the favoured west side of Bury St. Edmunds with the added benefit of off-road parking and private courtyard garden. The accommodation schedule comprises 3 bedrooms, family bathroom, kitchen and sitting/dining room. **NO ONWARD CHAIN.**

SITTING/DINING ROOM: A versatile reception room located to the rear of the property with French style double doors opening onto the courtyard garden.

BEDROOM 1: Spacious double bedroom located to the front of the property with dual aspect windows to front.

BEDROOM 2: Double bedroom with window to rear aspect.

BEDROOM 3: Window to rear aspect.

BATHROOM: With white suite comprising WC, hand wash basin and panelled bath with shower attachment over. Airing cupboard housing the hot water cylinder.

Outside

The property has the benefit of unallocated **OFF-ROAD PARKING** and a private courtyard garden deliberately low maintenance in nature, predominantly laid to block paving with fencing to three sides and personnel gate leading to the parking area at the rear.


