















With No Onward Chain! Thought to have been originally constructed in the mid 1700's, this delightful stone built mid-terrace is ideally positioned on Path Head, Blaydon. Located just off Summerhill, Path Head, a no through road provides excellent access to Blaydon shopping centre, local pubs, schooling and transport links to both Newcastle city centre and Winlaton.

The accommodation briefly comprises: entrance hall with stairs to first floor; sitting room with feature fireplace and tiled flooring; dining room with feature wood burning stove, stripped wood flooring and under-stairs storage cupboard; snug with feature fireplace and exposed beams; kitchen with fitted units, work surfaces, dual windows and rear door access to the yard. The first floor landing gives access to two double bedrooms; bedroom one with dual windows, feature fireplace and stripped wood flooring; bedroom two with feature fireplace and stripped wood flooring; bathroom complete with three piece suite. Externally, a front town garden with mature planting and dwarf wall boundary and to the rear, an enclosed yard, generous in size and paved throughout. 


