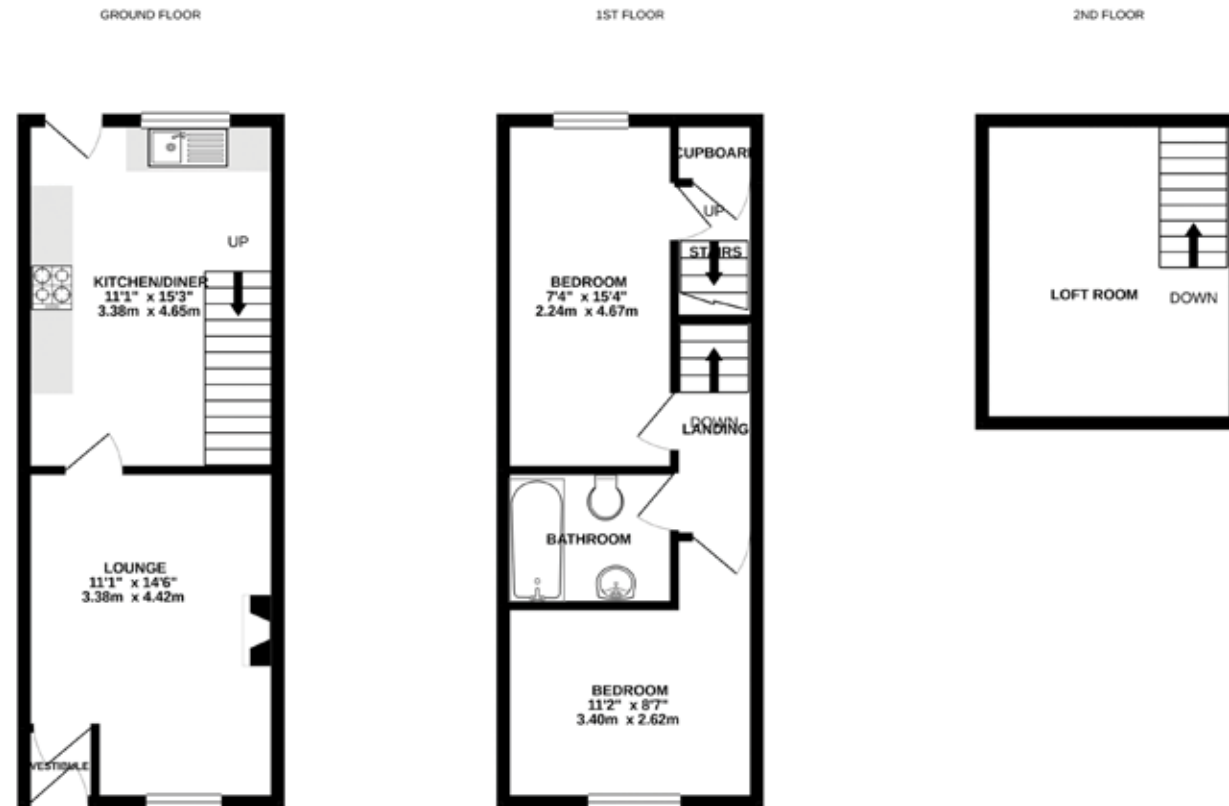

DESCRIPTION

In further detail, the accommodation on offer comprises an entrance vestibule opening into the lounge with original cast iron range, spacious kitchen diner with a range of fitted wall and base units in a Shaker style with integrated oven and hob and black worktops over, there is a barn door to the rear and staircase leading to the first floor. The first floor houses a landing, the family bathroom complete with WC, wash basin and bath with shower over. The master bedroom looking out to the front and bedroom two with access to the loft room. The loft room provides excellent additional space and has a skylight window to the rear.

Externally there is an enclosed yard to the rear with gate onto the communal garden providing additional seating areas and artificial grass.

LOCATION

Chapel-en-le-Frith, known as 'The Capital of the Peak' nestles in an upland valley in the High Peak and is surrounded by dramatic landscape of gritstone ridges and shapely hills. The town takes its name from a small chapel built in 1225 by the keepers of the Royal Forest that is now the Church of St Thomas Becket, where 1,500 Scottish soldiers were imprisoned during the Civil War. The historic town center also features a traditional marketplace which still has its original renowned stocks which the local cafe takes its name. A common phrase you hear many residents say is "We are so lucky to live here" even after living in the town for decades. That is further, solid evidence, if ever it was needed that Chapel-en-le-Frith and its

surrounding town and villages is an excellent place to set up home.
