**LOCATION:** The property sits to one side of this modern development ideally placed on the outskirts of Wellington, yet still within walking distance of the town centre. The County Town of Taunton is approximately 8 miles distant with its mainline railway station and the M5 can be accessed via Junction 26 just outside the town.

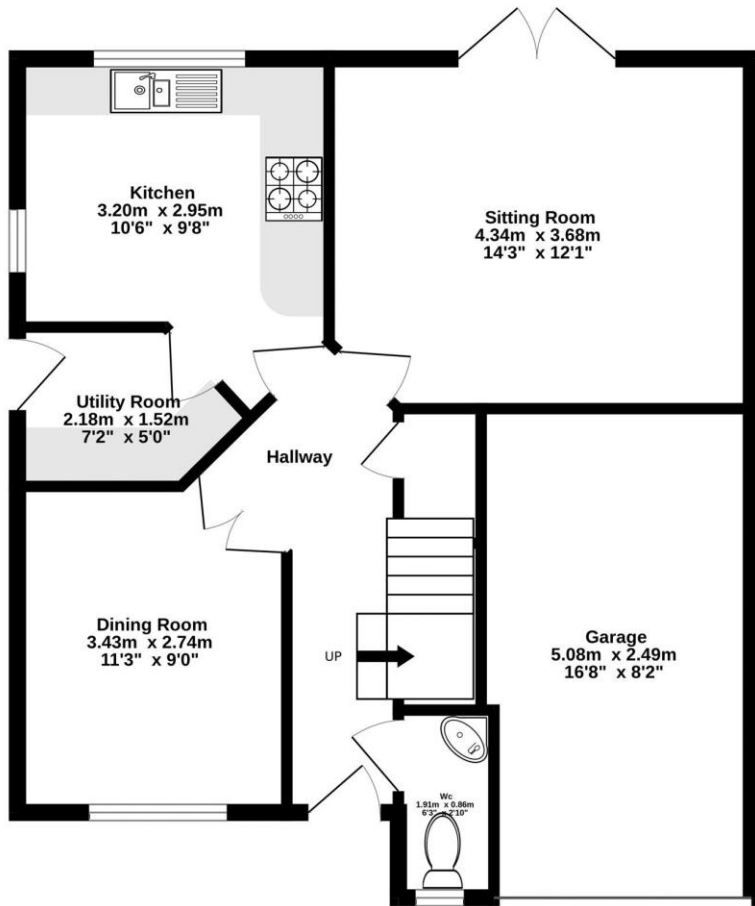

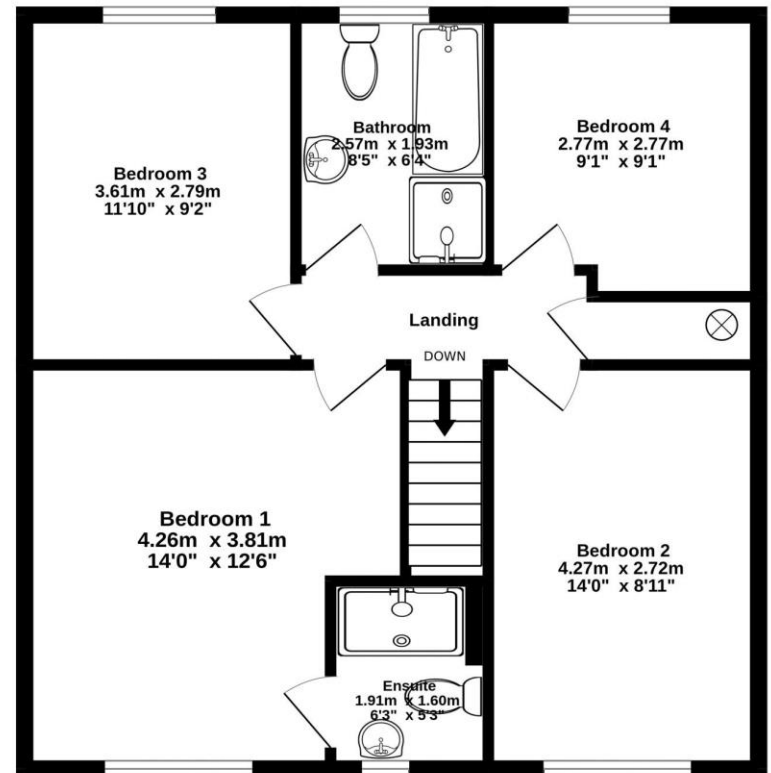

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69 Mills Drive is a beautifully maintained and presented 4 bedroom detached family home set in a pleasant plot position on the edge of the Hunters Green development, built by Wainhomes to 'The Scott' design in 2017. The property enjoys a generous amount of flexible accommodation that would suit the needs of many buyer profiles and the evolving priorities of a growing family.

The accommodation comprises in brief; a replacement front door opens into the entrance hallway with downstairs cloakroom, stairs to the first floor and doors to the principal rooms. The kitchen is sited to the rear of the house, fitted with a comprehensive range of wall and base units with an integrated oven, hob and dishwasher. Adjoining the kitchen is the utility room with a continuation of the units, plumbing for a washing machine and a door to the garden.

Completing the ground floor are two reception rooms; a sitting room to the rear with feature electric fire and French doors to the garden; alongside the dining room at the front of the property.

To the first floor, there are four good sized bedrooms with the master enjoying a spacious en-suite. The family bathroom is fitted with a four piece white suite with bath and additional shower.

Outside, the property benefits from off road parking on the driveway in turn leading to the garage with light and power connected, up and over door and venting for a tumble dryer. The main garden lies to the rear and has been landscaped to include an area of lawn, patio and seating area to the rear, affording a lovely view back towards the house.
