




37 George Street Wellington TA21 8HZ E259,950 Freehold







LOCATION: Wellington is a popular market town boasting an assortment of both independently run shops and larger national stores to include the well renowned Waitrose whilst also benefitting from a range of educational and leisure facilities, a Sport Centre, cinema and The Cleve Hotel & Spa. The landmark Wellington Monument showcases extensive views across the Blackdown Hills which is an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. There is also a regular bus service to outlying villages and to the County Town of Taunton which is approximately 7 miles distant with its main line railway station. The M5 Motorway can be accessed via Junction 26 just outside Wellington.







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A delightful three bedroom mid terrace character red brick home situated in a popular residential street within walking distance of Wellington town centre. The property is now offered to the market with NO ONWARD CHAIN.

The accommodation comprises in brief; front door opens into the entrance hallway with stairs rising to the first floor and doors to the principal rooms.

The sitting room lies to the front of the property with a bay window and open fireplace, whilst sitting centrally is a second reception room, currently used as a dining area, with ample space for furnishings, an under stairs storage cupboard and open fireplace.

To the rear of the property, the kitchen is fitted with a comprehensive range of wall and base units with space for a cooker, washing machine and fridge/freezer with a door to the rear garden.

To the first floor there is a spacious double bedroom and a single serviced by the family bathroom which is fitted with a three piece suite. To the second floor there is an additional double bedroom with a dormer window.

Externally, the property is set back from the road with a small front garden whilst the main garden lies to the rear and is predominantly laid to lawn. As is the norm with this style of property, there is a right of way for access across the rear. On road parking can be found in the street.
