Crofters Cottage is a delightful Grade II listed home enjoying an idyllic setting in Burghfield Common, a well-connected village with countryside charm.

This 4-bedroom home has been subject to sympathetic refurbishment, enhancing the original features which blends country cottage feel with the flexibility of modern living.

Standing on an established private plot of 0.39 acres the home has ample parking and a spacious garden which offers plenty of room for outdoor activities, entertaining or simply relaxing.

Downstairs, the kitchen has been designed with functionality in mind and thoughtfully paired with contemporary fittings for a stylish yet homely space.

The sitting room offers a cosy space with a classic wood burner, serving as a charming focal feature of the room. Adjacent to the sitting room is a bar area, perfect for entertaining guests.

Just across the entrance hall, a second reception room/snug awaits, complete with an open fire and exposed beams, adding both warmth and character. A studio room is also located on the ground floor, a versatile space ideal for use as a home office.

Completing the downstairs is a ground floor bathroom, separate cloakroom, dining room and utility room which adds practicality to the home's layout.

There are four generously sized bedrooms all of which can be independently accessed. A family bathroom completes the upstairs.

Outside, a patio area provides the perfect spot for al fresco dining or summer gatherings. The garden also has a substantial outbuilding which could be used as a workshop or for additional storage.

Burghfield Common is conveniently located for Reading, Newbury and Basingstoke.

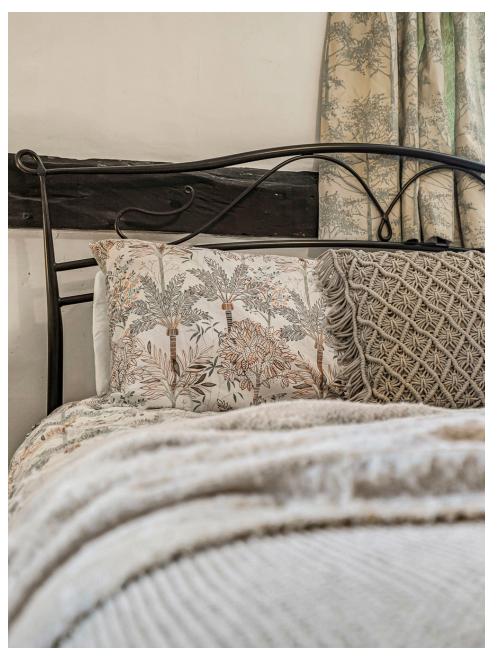

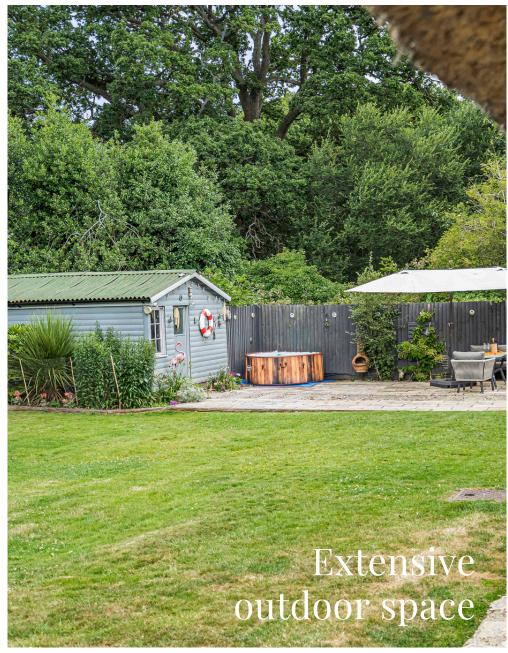

Gardening has been full of surprises, including a buried WWI pickle jar! We've loved the community events too — Burghfest and the Box Cart Race are annual highlights.





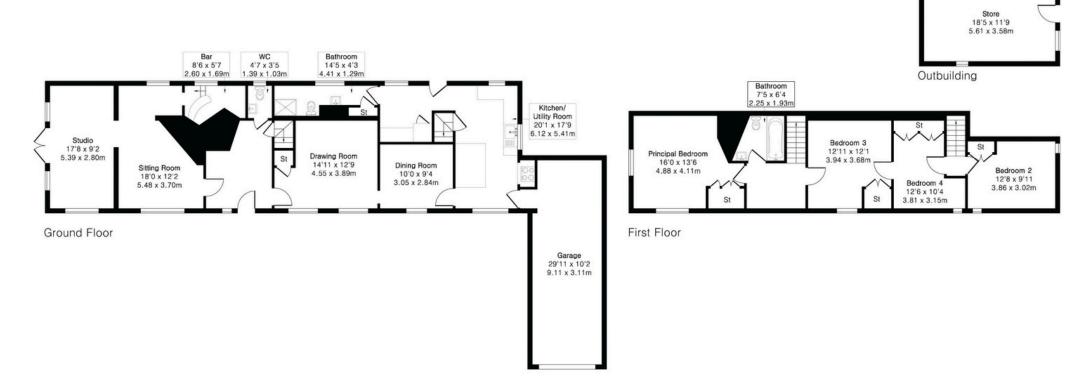

#### Transport

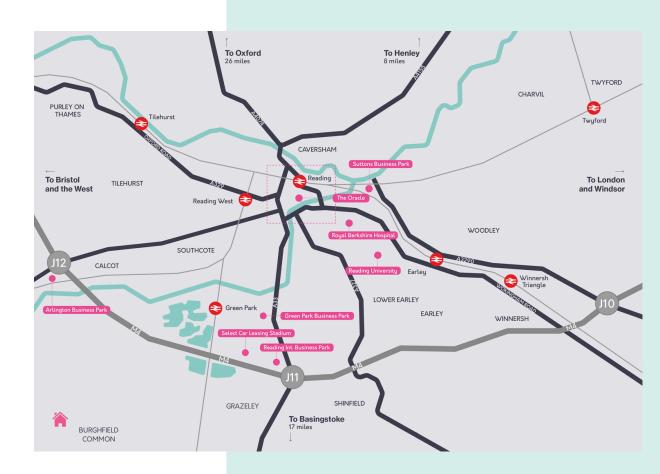
Burghfield is ideally situated near major road networks with links to the M4 motorway and A33 for quick access to London, Basingstoke and Swindon. Nearby stations at Mortimer and Theale provide direct services to Reading and beyond.

#### Schooling

There is a selection of Primary and Secondary schools in the surrounding area, including Burghfield StMary's C.E. Primary and The Willink School. The University of Reading is also just a short commute away.

#### Leisure and Entertainment

There is a selection of well-known pubs which have delicious food and entertainment, The Six Bells is a village favourite or you can head over to The Cunning Man located on the riverside. Residents enjoy a variety of leisure options, from sports at Willink Leisure Centre to scenic walks and cycle routes in the surrounding countryside. Families make use of local parks and playgrounds, while outdoor enthusiasts can fish at Burghfield Main Lake or enjoy watersports at nearby Lagoona Park.



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
