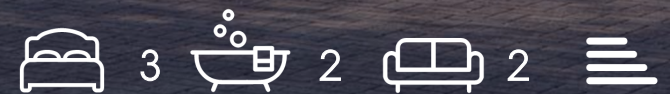

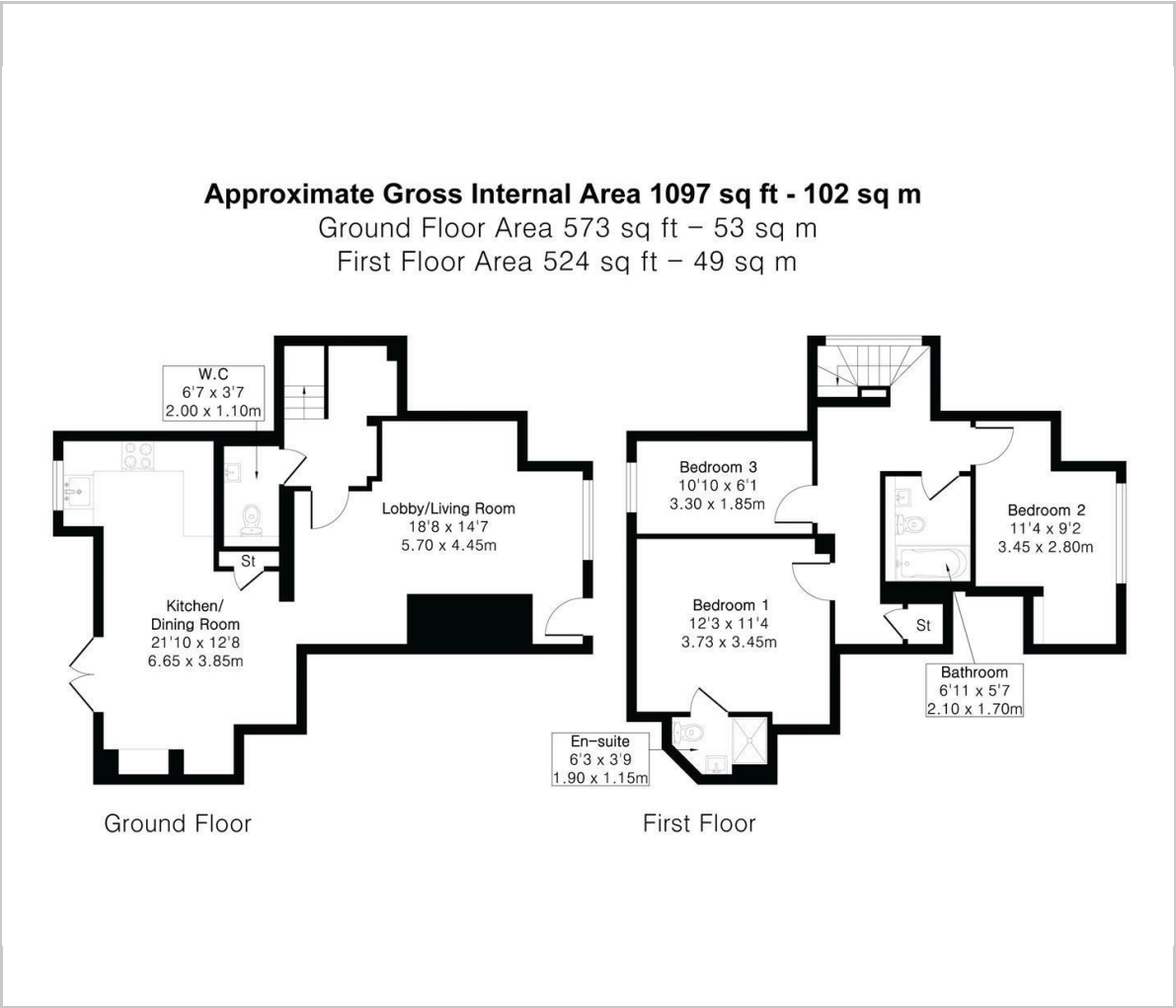

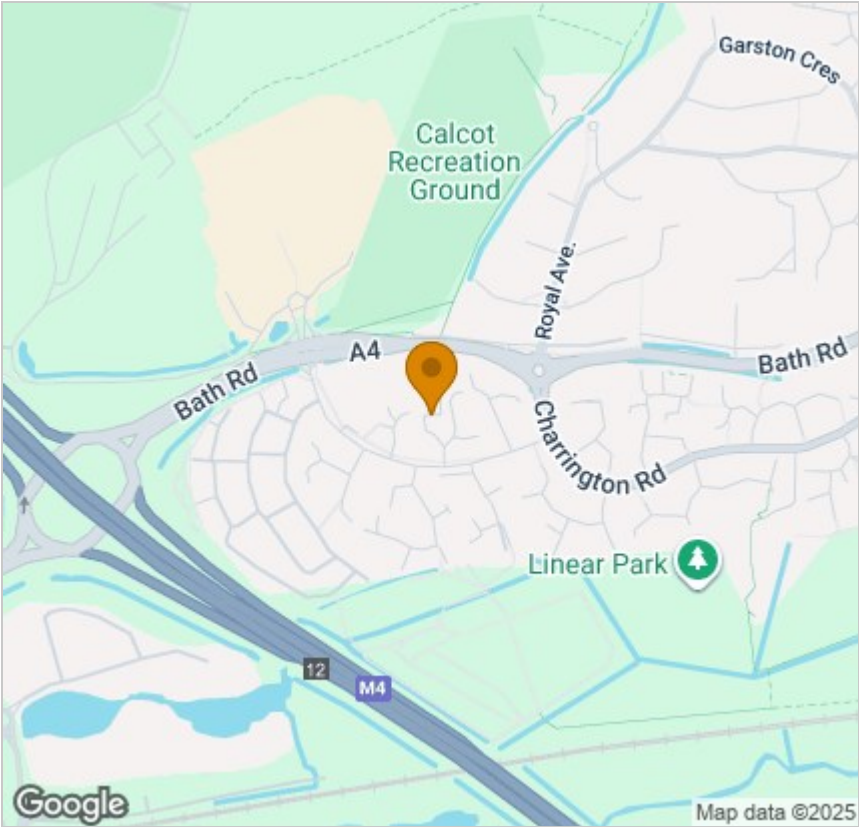
Floor Plan



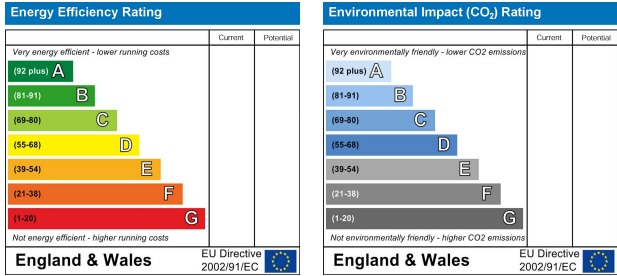
