

West Street, Lewes



West Street is in the heart of Lewes Town Centre opposite the historic Needlemakers with its independent, specialist shops and café. Only a little further is Lewes High Street with its historical aura of period properties, individual shops, bars, cafés and restaurants. There are very close walks to the river via the Phoenix Bridge and Pells area, with pond, recreation ground, wetlands and open air swimming pool. Lewes Railway Station is only a ten minute walk or less, connecting to London Victoria (1hr), London Bridge (90mins) and Brighton (20mins). Lewes is a joy, nestled in the South Downs with the River Ouse and the Norman Castle dominating proceedings.




