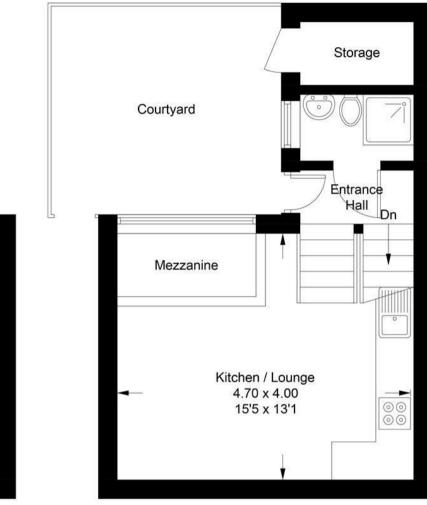

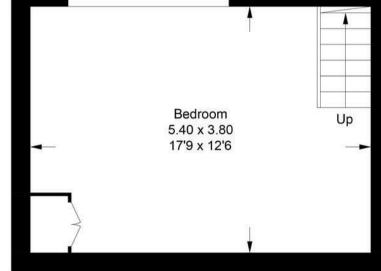












Ground Floor
