







This map shows the chance of flooding where rainwater has nowhere to drain. This kind of flooding can occur far from rivers or seas.

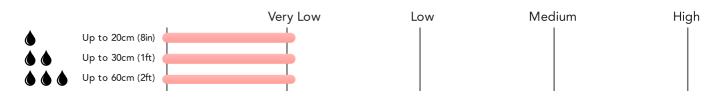




