DESCRIPTION

A two bedroom period mid terraced house in this central Beverley location very close to the Minster and enjoying views to the front over Hall Garth, a historic monument.

The property retains some period features including a fabulous cast iron range in the rear reception room but is ready for some cosmetic upgrading. There are some indications of damp in areas of the ground floor that may need management or treatment. The property is gas centrally heated and has double glazed sash style windows in many rooms.

The property briefly comprises: Living and Dining Rooms, a Breakfast Area that may provide a study space leading to a fitted Kitchen and then a WC Cloaks. To the first floor are 2 Double Bedrooms, both with period style fireplaces, and a Bathroom leading off the rear bedroom. There is a rear yard.

Hallgarth is the site of the moated medieval residence of the Bishop of York and a scheduled ancient monument. It is used as pasture for cattle during the appropriate season and is fenced off with a low level fence. It is a very tranquil outlook amongst the hustle and bustle of Beverley and we are sure it will be of particular appeal to any purchaser.
