This well-presented three-bedroom home has been thoughtfully updated throughout and offers spacious, modern living across two floors, complemented by landscaped gardens to the front and rear. Situated in the heart of the village of Nantymoel, this beautifully maintained three-bedroom mid-terrace property has been a much-loved family home for the past 25 years. Built in the early 1900s, it combines period character with modern comfort throughout. The spacious lounge/dining room features a welcoming gas fire and bay window. The refitted kitchen (installed just two years ago) includes integrated appliances including a fridge/freezer high level oven and wine chiller. Upstairs, there are three bedrooms, perfect for a growing family or first-time buyers. Outside, the property boasts a landscaped, low-maintenance tiered rear garden with rear lane access. An ideal first-time buy or family home, offering modern convenience within a friendly village community.

Ground Floor The property is entered via a UPVC double-glazed front door leading into an entrance porch with vinyl flooring, radiator, and a wooden glazed door opening into the openplan lounge/dining room. The lounge/dining room features a charming bay window to the front allowing plenty of natural light, and ample space for both living and dining furniture. A feature fireplace provides a focal point to the room, while a staircase leads to the first floor. A doorway from the dining area opens to the rear passage, which has vinyl flooring and space to store coats. The kitchen, accessed from the rear passage, has been fitted within the last two years and offers a stylish range of base, wall, and drawer units with complementary work surfaces and matching up stands. It includes a single bowl sink unit, integrated fridge/freezer, integrated wine cooler, high-level oven with integrated microwave, and a four-ring electric hob with decorative glass splash back. The walls are fully tiled, and a skylight window adds extra natural light. A window and rear door open directly to the garden. The family bathroom, also accessed from the rear passage, comprises a three-piece suite including a panelled bath with

thermostatic shower over, a vanity unit with inset wash basin, and WC. The room is fully tiled, with an extractor fan, glass shower screen, and window to the rear.

First Floor Carpeted stairs lead to the first-floor landing, which provides access to three bedrooms. The main bedroom, located at the front of the property, is a double room with fitted carpet, sliding mirrored wardrobes, and a window to the front aspect. Bedroom two overlooks the rear garden and is another double room, featuring a built-in cupboard housing the Vaillant wall-mounted combi boiler. Bedroom three is a single room with fitted carpet and a window to the front aspect. Outside The property is approached by steps leading to a patio courtyard at the front, enclosed by railings and a gate.

To the rear, the landscaped tiered garden offers several distinct spaces. Steps lead from the property to the first patio level, which provides a pleasant seating area enclosed by galvanised steel railings. There is a large wooden storage shed with power and light. Further steps and a gate lead to the second tier, featuring artificial lawn and an additional patio area. A rear gate provides access to a lane behind the property.

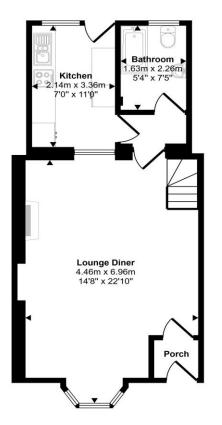

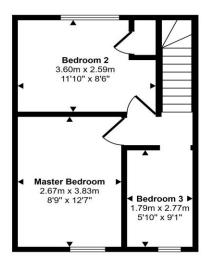
