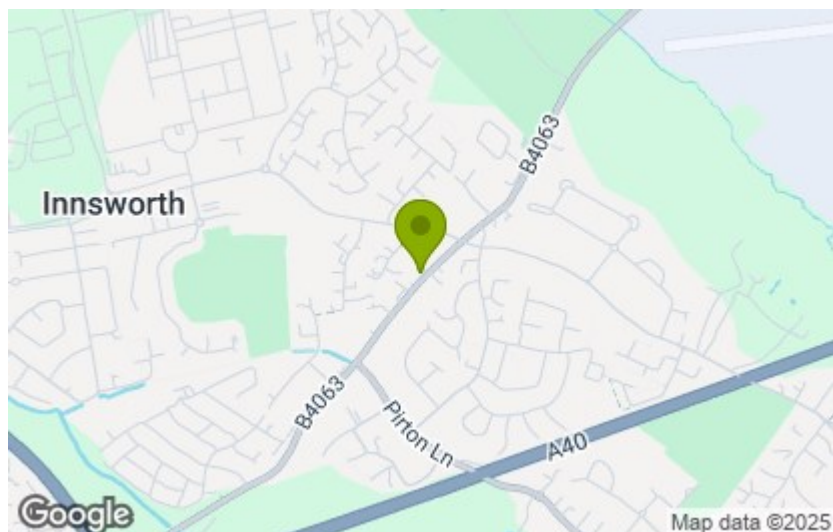


Ground Floor
