




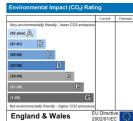
Floor Plan Area Map
