




IF YOU LIVED HERE ...

With Walthamstow Village to the north, Leyton to the south and Hollow Ponds to the east, you can walk in almost any direction and find somewhere interesting to explore. ranging from award-winning eateries to nature trails, but let's start with the view from home

Or head down towards Leyton Midland Road arches where you've got some buzzy new choices, including the much lauded smokehouse Burnt ('dreamy' according to the Guardian), as well as Gravity Well Taproom.

Looking for public transport options? You can reach Levton Midland Road in just 12 minutes, where the Overground runs between Gospel Oak and Barking line, allowing easy interchange to the tube network. Buses are also plentiful, with routes running on Lea Bridge Road and Leyton High Road. Walthamstow Central is only 18 mins away for the excellent Victoria line too.

WHAT ELSE?

- You've got a choice of great local pubs in nearly all directions, including the bustling William The Fourth on the Leyton High Road (eight mins), the award-winning Castle in Walthamstow Village (six mins) and the Lord Raglan (ten mins) with its fantastic curry menu

-You won't ever be stuck for essential items thanks to the great selection of convenience stores on Leyton High Road. Tesco Superstore is a short walk away. After something a bit fancy? 'London's poshest Spar' (according to the Evening Standard) can be found in the village, with a brilliant selection of deli items.
A mere minute away on foot you'll find a brilliant new addition to Lea Bridge Road,
