'What I especially like about the location is that it's so near everything: 3 minutes walk from Wood Street station, 9 minutes walk to Epping Forest and literally 1 minute from a lovely community garden. Walthamstow Cricket, Tennis and Squash club is only 5 minutes walk, too. Situated at the end of a cul-de-sac, it is very quiet. The added bonus of being an end of terrace means there is additional width to the property which adds to the light and spacious feeling of the house and garden. It's hard to think it's 20 minutes from Liverpool Street! I enjoy being right near the amenities of Wood Street. It is definitely up and coming with lots of lovely independent cafe's and bakery's and some interesting bars and eateries springing up, as well as a great community library and indoor market. On top of that, the Village is only a few minutes walk away with its eclectic mix of shops, pubs and restaurants.'

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Outside, you have a fantastic neighbourhood to explore... Head nine minutes on foot towards St Peters-in-the-Forest to enjoy the tranquility of Epping Forest, which is dotted with clearings perfect for picnics, or head in the other direction towards Hollow Ponds for more sprawling nature and even a boating lake. Fancy more of an urban buzz? You're in luck because the nearby Wood Street is having a real moment and it's right on your doorstep. Not only does it look great thanks to the good work of local mural studio Wood Street Walls, but several exciting new stores and eateries have popped up amongst the old favourites, like the brilliantly unique Wood Street Indoor Market and local institution garden centre Lancasters. Not sure where to start? Try excellent cider tap room Luke's, rustic Balkan dining spot Lacy Nook, tasty brunch spot Dudley's and award-win bakery Chocolatine, but there's much more. You're also only a 12 minute stroll to the Ravenswood Industrial Estate, which is home to the ever-popular God's Own Junkyard, as well as Pillars, Trap, Mother's Ruin and the new Malt Haus.

·Walthamstow Village is only a 15 minute stroll away, where you've got everything from tapas food and authentic sushi to fish and chips and gastro grub. - Parents will be pleased to know you have plenty of great primary/secondary schools in the area.
