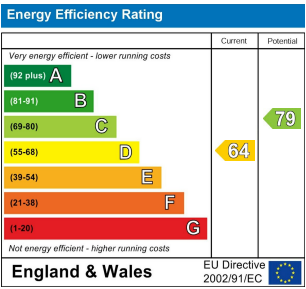
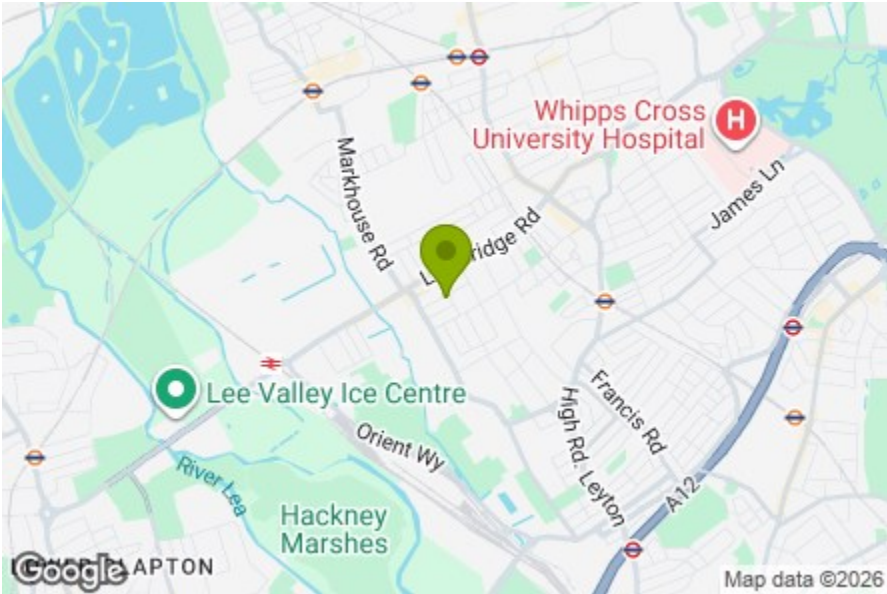

This Victorian conversion sits within a charming terrace of period homes, defined by warm brickwork, white-painted bay windows, and elegant detailing around the arches and openings. A small gated front garden leads to the private entrance, where stairs rise to the first floor.

At the heart of the flat, a central hallway connects each room. The landing continues the home's calm palette with light wood flooring and soft-toned walls, while a white balustrade adds character to the space.

The kitchen and reception room is located at the front, with a generous bay window that fills the space with natural light. Pale walls and wood flooring give it a neutral, adaptable feel, while the kitchen area includes built-in wood-effect cabinetry, a gas hob, and integrated oven. The layout is straightforward, offering a natural flow between cooking, dining, and relaxing.

To the rear, the main bedroom is a peaceful retreat, with clean white walls, oak flooring, and a sash window that looks out over neighbouring rooftops. Its simple styling and soft light create a restful atmosphere.
