

Striking the perfect balance between period charm and contemporary convenience, this split-level apartment has been thoughtfully updated—including a loft conversion—making it an even rarer find than your typical iconic ex-Warner home.

Spanning 775 square feet, there's plenty of space to spread out, while the clever layout allows for distinct zones to suit every part of your day-to-day life. The neutral explosion and contemporary finites set is effectled by plantide violated datally like the
