














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IF YOU LIVED HERE ...

First up is the bathroom – a bright, thoughtfully finished space with crisp white metro tiles, both a walk-in rainfall shower and a separate bathtub, an integrated vanity, and a standout sash window with stained glass accents in vibrant red and blue for a pop of colour against the neutral grey decor.

Next, the kitchen/diner – fitted with white shaker-style cabinetry and dark wood worktops, offering plenty of storage and prep space. Buff-toned walls and slate-coloured tiling add warmth and contrast, while a window overlooking the garden and Velux overhead bathe the space in natural light, making it a great spot for morning coffee or sociable evening meals.

Ascending the softly carpeted stairs further brings you to the top floor, opening into a 20-foot reception room with rich dark flooring that grounds the space beautifully against the clean white walls. A Velux window adds light without compromising privacy.

"I loved the quirky layout of the flat immediately, over multiple floors and with large rooms it felt so much more spacious than a one bedroom flat. Fast forward to the covid years, and the large living room made it possible to have a work at home space that still felt separate from my living space. WHAT ELSE?

- Walthamstow Central Station has fantastic transport links, including the Victoria and Overground lines, as well as plenty of buses to choose from. Direct 20-minute runs to Liverpool Street and Oxford Circus, putting both the City and West End within easy reach.

- After a big refurbishment, Soho Theatre Walthamstow has recently launched with quirky comedy and cutting-edge international performers, as well as a great bar.

- The peaceful, leafy oasis of Walthamstow Village, is home to a huge range of independent bars and restaurants as well as artisanal dog-friendly gastropubs. - Walthamstow High Street and famous street market - the longest in Europe is within easy reach, and with Hoe Street close by, you'll find more amazing restaurants, tons of history and some of the best pubs in East London to help convince vou, too.

- Walthamstow Wetlands, covering 500 acres and Europe's largest urban nature reserve, is 25 minutes on foot or just 5 minutes by bike is the perfect place to escape the city
