

The open layout makes it ideal for both dining and relaxing, with a simple finish that brings a sense of flexibility throughout.

In the main bedroom, warm flooring and soft tones create a calm retreat, complemented by an adjoining shower room tiled in a contemporary style. Another bedroom at the rear of the property benefits from large windows and a glazed door leading directly to the communal gardens, ensuring a seamless link between indoor and outdoor living.

The kitchen is functional yet full of character, with patterned flooring and contrasting finishes enhancing its appeal, while the family bathroom is bright and neatly arranged, complete with bath and overhead shower. A utility room provides extra convenience and rounds off the interior layout.

The surrounding area offers a varied mix of local character and natural escape. Wood Street Indoor Market is close by, home to vintage treasures, independent stalls and a lively atmosphere. A short distance away, Walthamstow Village brims with charm, where The Castle pub and Eat17 provide popular spots for food and drink. For something more eclectic, Gods Own Junkyard dazzles with its neon lights, paired with craft beer and bites in a one-of-a-kind setting. The Flowerpot, a welcoming local pub, is perfect for a relaxed evening closer to home. When you need a breath of fresh air, Bulrush Pond in Epping Forest provides a tranquil retreat among nature, while the forest itself stretches for miles with woodland walks, cycling paths and open glades to explore at leisure.

Wood Street Station is just a short three-minute walk, placing the Overground within easy reach for swift connections across London. The area is also well served by an extensive bus network, with routes running directly to Walthamstow Central, Leyton and other surrounding neighbourhoods. With both rail and bus options close at hand, daily travel is straightforward and well connected, whether for work, leisure or exploring further afield.
