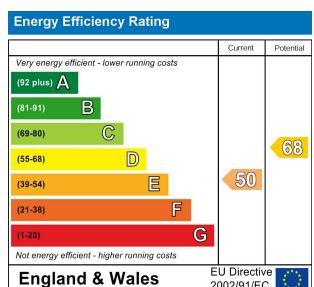

there's plenty of other perks on your doorstep, including tasty brunch spot The Curious Goat and bar/pizzeria True Craft. You're just a short hop from Blackhorse Beer Mile, featuring some of East London's most exciting craft beer breweries, bars and street food, such as Exale, Signature Brew and Big Penny Social - all have a packed event calendar.

If you need to travel further afield, St James Street station is five minutes on foot for quick access to Liverpool Street on the overground, while Walthamstow Central is 13 minutes for the speedy Victoria line into the West End.



WHAT ELSE?

- Fancy doing something a bit different? Situated in Walthamstow PumpHouse Museum - an eight minute walk away, supperclub.tube offers an incredible dining experience in a refurbished tube carriage.

- Conveniently you've got a fantastic coffee shop - Beaten by a Whisker - three minutes away. Weirdough Bakery is another great option for tasty treats, and a similar distance.

- Despite all this urban living, you're actually still surrounded by greenery; Walthamstow Wetlands is less than a mile away, and you're also within walking distance of Walthamstow Marshes and Lloyd Park.
