Bourne Court is a peaceful, secluded scheme a 20 minute walk from Aldershot town centre. There is also a regular bus into town, which stops just down the road.

In the town centre there are various shops, a library, health centre and dental practice, as well as a bus depot and railway station.

Our facilities:

Part time scheme managers are employed to provide support and advice to the residents. When they are not on duty, the scheme benefits from a pull-cord alarm system linked to a Control Centre, from which assistance can be called 24-hours a day, seven days per week.

The scheme includes a communal garden, laundry, guest room, and lounge where we regularly hold afternoon tea, quizzes, and charity events.

The communal areas are maintained by Sanctuary Housing Association (cleaning and repairs), although residents are responsible for repairs within their own flats.

Some residents are keen to help maintain the gardens and the Association actively welcomes the involvement of residents in helping to enhance the scheme.
