
THE LOUNGE

THE SUN ROOM & DINING ROOM








FLOOR PLAN, DIMENSIONS & MAP

THE LOCATION

Burntisland is a delightful coastal town to the east of the Forth bridges upon the shores of the Firth of Forth. Within the Burntisland which oozes charm and character there is a selection of shopping for everyday requirements and a local primary school of good repute.







The majority of secondary school pupils attend Balwearie High School in nearby Kirkcaldy Burntisland is known for its sandy Blue Flag beach, the 15th century Rossend Castle, and its traditional summer fair and Highland games day. To the north of the town, a hill called The Binn is a landmark of the Fife coastline. Burntisland railway station serves the town and provides direct links with, amongst other stops, Kirkcaldy to the north and Edinburgh to the south and there are regular bus services.









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
