Harrington Drive, Macclesfield

A generously proportioned three-bedroom detached family home, ideally located in one of Macclesfield's most desirable areas. This attractive property is conveniently positioned within close proximity to a wide range of local amenities, well regarded schools, and excellent recreational facilities. The accommodation briefly comprises an entrance porch leading into a welcoming hallway, a spacious lounge, separate dining room, a large and airy conservatory, a contemporary kitchen, and a useful utility room. Upstairs, the first floor offers three well sized bedrooms and a stylish three-piece family bathroom. Externally, the property boasts a well-maintained front lawn and ample off-road parking, which extends to a single garage. To the rear, one of the standout features is the beautifully landscaped garden, complete with a generous patio area and a charming summerhouse, perfect for outdoor entertaining or relaxation.



Driveway

On approach there is a lawned garden with stocked borders, ample off road parking which extends to a good size garage – with an up and over door, power and light.

Entrance Porch 7' 1" x 5' 1" (2.15m x 1.55m)

With an inner door through to the entrance hall. WC situated off the entrance porch having a WC and wash hand basin plus a cloaks storage cupboard and double glazed window.

WC 4' 3" x 6' 1" (1.30m x 1.86m)

Wash hand basin plus a cloaks storage cupboard and double glazed window.

Entrance Hall 7' 1" x 12' 1" (2.15m x 3.69m)

Stairs to the first floor landing, radiator.

Lounge 18' 4" x 12' 1" (5.58m x 3.69m)

Large formal lounge with a double glazed window to front, gas fire set in a complementary fireplace, radiator.

Dining Room 11' 4" x 8' 2" (3.46m x 2.49m)

Sliding patio door through to the conservatory, radiator, door to kitchen.

Conservatory 11' 3" x 11' 4" (3.44m x 3.46m)

A large conservatory having double glazed windows and double doors leading out to the rear patio and garden.

Kitchen 14' 0" x 8' 2" (4.27m x 2.49m)

Modern range of wall, base and drawer units, contrasting work surfaces, single drainer sink unit with a mixer tap over, integrated electric oven, gas hob and an extractor, integrated dishwasher, door to utility room and double glazed window to rear looking out onto the garden.

Utility room 12' 0" x 6' 4" (3.67m x 1.93m)

Double glazed window and door to rear garden, door to garage, wall mounted gas central heating boiler.

First Floor Landing 15' 11" x 9' 1" (4.85m x 2.77m)

Double glazed window to rear, access to the loft space.

Bedroom 1 14' 10" x 11' 2" (4.53m x 3.41m)

Double glazed windows to front, radiator.

Bedroom 2 10' 6" x 11' 2" (3.20m x 3.41m)

Double glazed window to front, radiator, stairwell storage cupboard.

Bedroom 3 9' 5" x 9' 1" (2.88m x 2.77m)

Double glazed window to rear, built in cupboard, radiator.

Bathroom 7' 4" x 5' 3" (2.23m x 1.60m)

Three piece suite comprising, panel bath, shower screen and an electric shower, WC and wash hand basin, part tiled walls, radiator, built in cupboard, double glazed windows to rear.

Rear Garden

To rear there is a laid to lawn garden with a large patio area, paved walkway and summer house.
