The light and welcoming sitting room features a striking fireplace, now fitted with a new log burner and flue, creating a perfect focal point for the room and a cosy atmosphere on cooler evenings. French doors open out to the attractive rear garden, allowing natural light to fill the space.


The kitchen and dining room provide an excellent space for family life and entertaining, fitted with a comprehensive range of modern units and integrated appliances including a fridge/freezer, washing machine, dishwasher, and eye-level double oven. Underfloor heating extends throughout this area and the adjoining cloakroom, adding a sense of comfort and warmth. There is ample space for a large dining table, ideal for family gatherings or relaxed suppers with friends.


On the first floor, the principal bedroom benefits from built-in wardrobes and a stylish en-suite shower room, both enjoying underfloor heating. There are two further bedrooms, one of which also has built-in wardrobes, together with a wellappointed family bathroom, again benefiting from underfloor heating.

The property has been thoughtfully updated by the present owners, with newly laid flooring throughout and the installation of a new electric boiler, improving both efficiency and presentation.



The Area

Windmill Hill is a charming and sought-after village set within the parish of Herstmonceux, just a short drive from the market town of Hailsham. The area is surrounded by beautiful Sussex countryside and is home to the impressive Grade II* listed Windmill, which stands as a local landmark and a proud reminder of the village's heritage.

The village itself enjoys a friendly community atmosphere with a range of everyday amenities available in nearby Herstmonceux, including a doctors' surgery, convenience store, post office, and a choice of local pubs and eateries. Popular spots include Geo's Coffee House, a welcoming café serving artisan coffees and homemade cakes, The Sundial fine dining restaurant, a well-regarded Indian restaurant, and Willows Fish and Chip Shop, a local favourite for a takeaway. The nearby Brewers Arms offers traditional pub fare and a warm village setting, perfect for an evening meal or Sunday lunch.


Regular bus services connect Windmill Hill with surrounding towns including Hailsham, Bexhill, and Eastbourne, providing convenient access to a wider range of shops, schools, and leisure facilities. Hailsham is approximately four miles away and offers several supermarkets, a leisure centre, independent shops, and a weekly market, while Eastbourne's seafront and mainline rail links are around a twenty-minute drive.




