Completed in 2024, Talskiddy was conceived by renowned architects Laurence Associates who demonstrate a prestigious portfolio across the South West. The premium specification and sympathetic design include local cut stone and Cedar external elevations, a reclaimed Delabole slate roof, high performance Aluminium windows and doors, a bespoke kitchen with hand crafted Pippi Oak cabinetry, Lusso bathroom furniture including scalloped marble tiles, engineered oak and slate floors, four Juliette balconies and an air source underfloor heating system.

The 3,431 square feet of luxurious and expansive accommodation includes five genuine double bedrooms each with herringbone weave carpets and a uniquely styled and sumptuous en-suite bathroom. The living spaces are generous and cleverly conceived, providing both ground and first floor living rooms together with a sociable kitchen/dining room that opens onto the enclosed rear patio. The aforementioned Pippi Oak kitchen is complimented by Corian and oak work surfaces and integrated appliances. Of further note is the separate utility room, boot room/study, inviting entrance hall, impressive first floor atrium and cloakroom. At first floor level, one can enjoy far reaching views of the ocean and a swathe of North Cornish coastline together with rural inland views to the rear.

Talskiddy has a striking and highly attractive external façade with fully enclosed landscaped gardens and grounds that extend to approximately 0.2 acres, combining expansive lawns and thoughtfully designed patios orientated towards the South. The majority of the boundaries consist of traditional Cornish stone hedging while the rear of the house is bordered by beautiful rolling fields. There is some fledgling planting within the gardens, ample gravelled driveway parking, a gated entrance and a detached summerhouse. Services to the property include mains electricity, water and drainage with an air source underfloor heating system. EPC rating B. Council tax band TBC. 




Of further benefit to Harlyn Bay is the hotly anticipated new farm shop, restaurant and taproom on the site of the former Harlyn Inn. The Championship Golf Course of Trevose in nearby Constantine Bay ranks as one of the top links courses in the British Isles, also offering tennis and padel court facilities.

To find Talskiddy, follow the B3276 coast road out of Padstow towards Trevone and Harlyn, taking signs to Newquay. Follow this road for approximately one mile before turning right signposted to Harlyn Bay. Follow the lane down past the beach at Harlyn and head over the bridge.
