The property's accommodation comprises: spacious lounge with feature multi fuel stove, kitchen refitted 2 years ago, having electric hob and oven, feature Victorian glazed wall cupboards, useful understairs storage cupboard and lobby with door to the rear garden, ground floor bathroom suite and to the first floor there are two bedrooms. 


Floorplan
